High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

A new high-speed railway station is being built within Solihull, near the M42, A45 Coventry Road and A446 Stonebridge Road, close to the NEC, Birmingham Business Park and Birmingham Airport.

As part of our ongoing works on the local highway network, we will be carrying out a series of snagging activities on the A446 Link Road and Biddles Loop near Bickenhill.

To ensure the safety of the public and our workforce, to minimise disruption. these activities will take place overnight.

A446 Link Road and Biddles Loop overnight closures:

- Each night from 8pm Tuesday 4 November until 6am on Sunday 9 November 2025

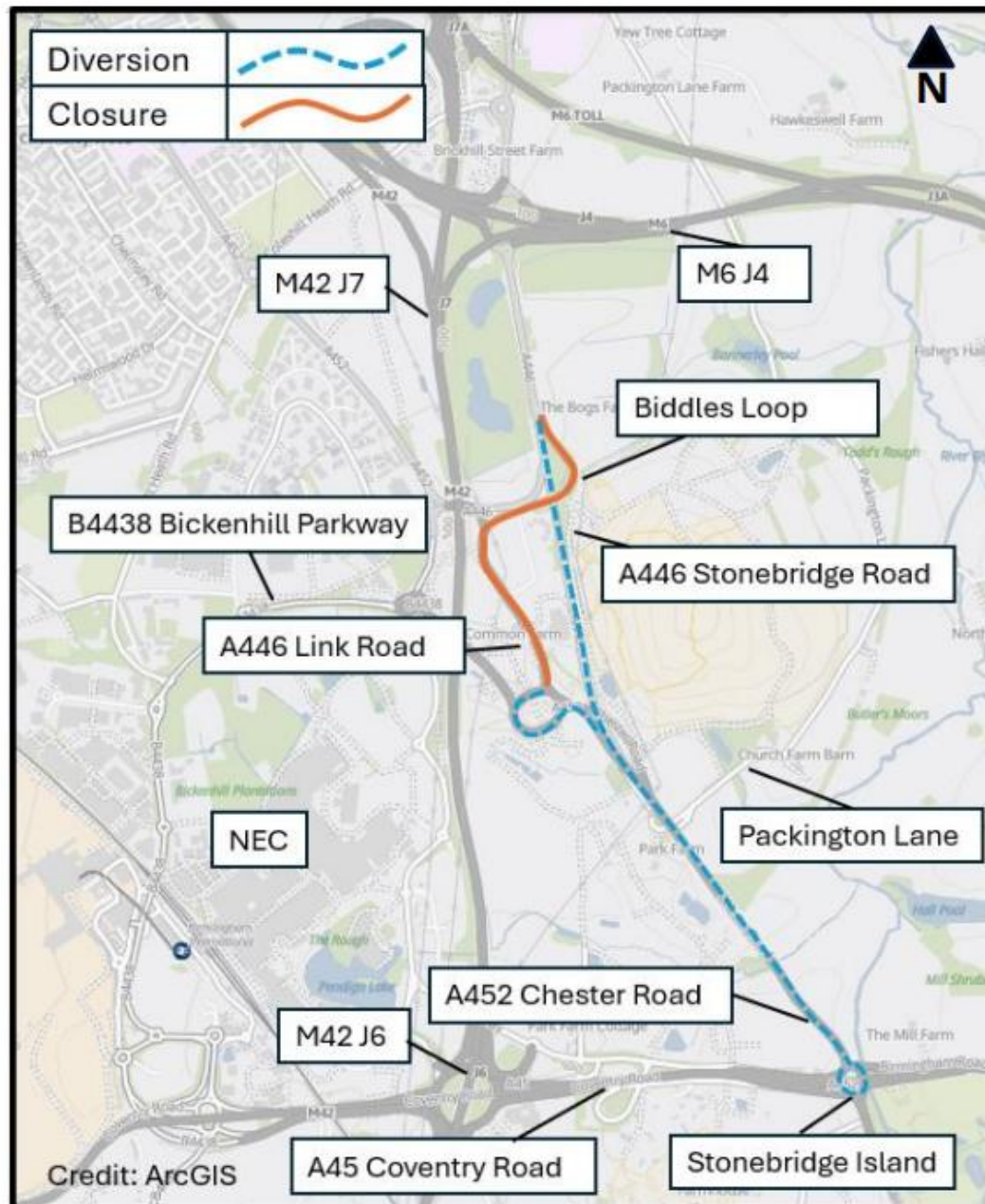
Southbound diversion

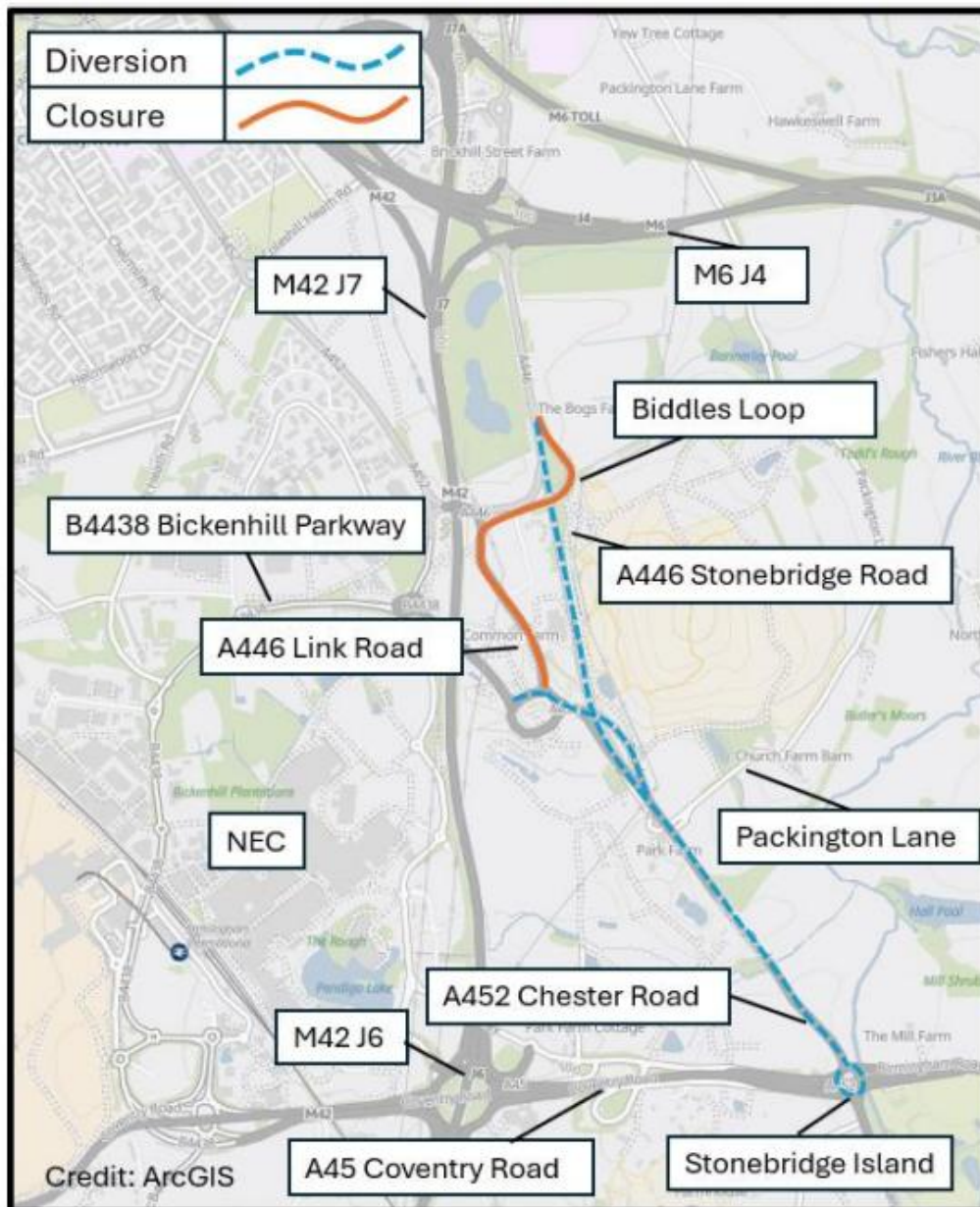
Northbound diversion
