Duration

From Monday 8 to Tuesday 16 December 2025 there will be three-way temporary traffic lights in operation 24/7.

Then between Wednesday 17 and Friday 19 December 2025 there will be daytime road closures between 9.30am - 3.30pm with overnight temporary traffic lights.

What we are doing

These works are to complete the new access for a local business and a number of utility connections on the Weston under Wetherley side. We will have further updates on the work available in the New Year.

What to expect

You may notice increased levels of construction activity and some travel disruption. Access for cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained throughout the works. There will be a fully signed diversion in place to help drivers navigate their way. Please see the map on page two.

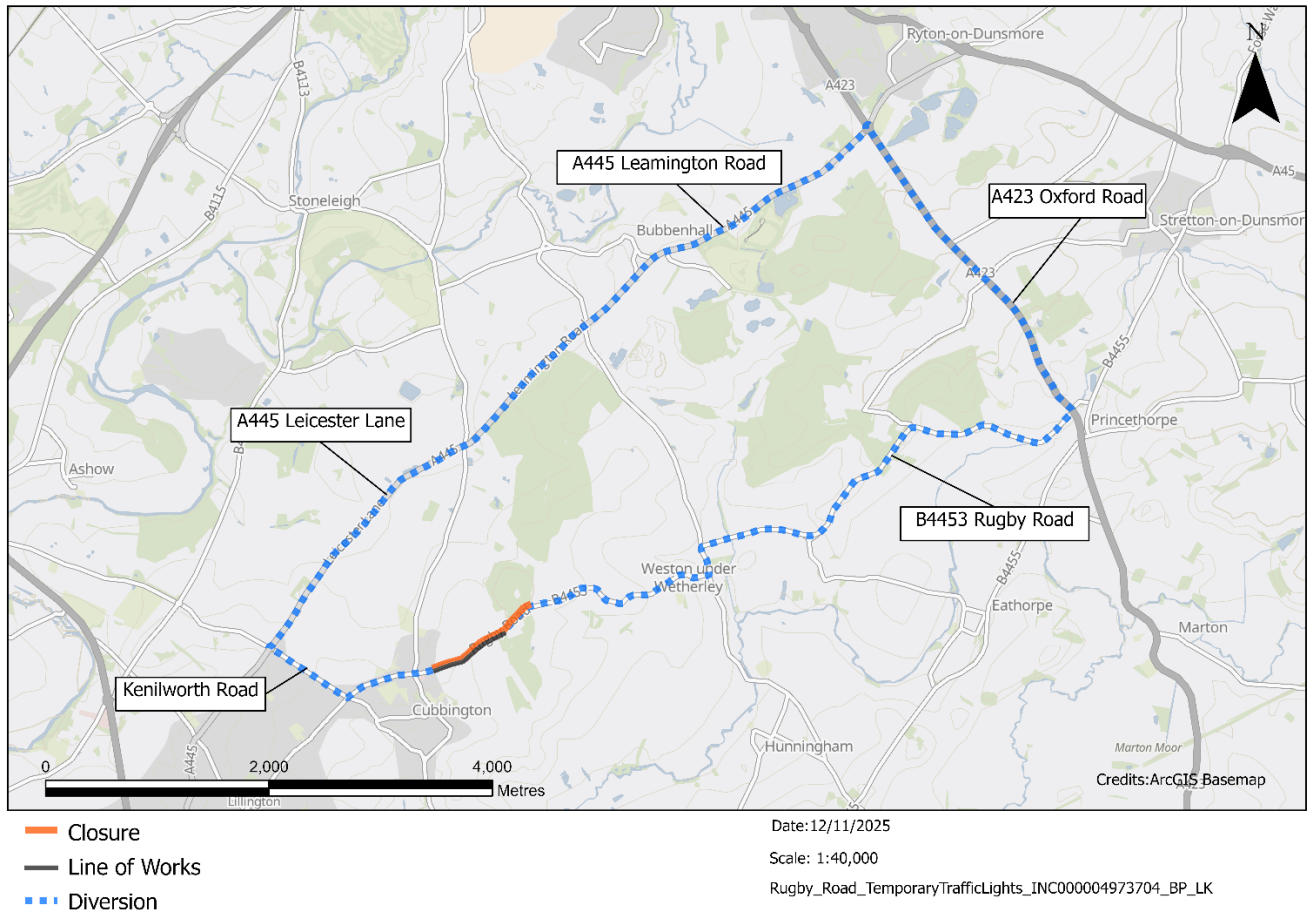
