# Notice of installation of traffic camera on Old Oak Common Lane

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

# What we are doing

From 6 to 7 December 2025, we will install an automatic number plate recognition (ANPR) camera on the south of Old Oak Common Lane, past the Network Rail bridge. The camera will be installed on an existing lamp post using a mobile working platform.

The camera will be in place for the duration of the HS2 works to monitor lorry movements to and from HS2 sites in your local area.

### How these works might affect you

To minimise disruption, we will install the camera during planned utilities works on Old Oak Common Lane by HS2's construction partner, Balfour Beatty Vinci Systra joint venture (BBVS JV).
