

Updated notice of road closures on B4113 Stoneleigh Road and Stareton Lane

Location

B4113 Stoneleigh Road and Stareton Lane, Stoneleigh near Stoneleigh Park

Duration

Last year we communicated the road closure for March 2026. We have now amended the dates: B4113 Stoneleigh Road will be closed 24 hours a day, seven days a week **from Monday 23 March now until Sunday 19 April 2026**

What we are doing

We will be working on the east tie-ins, in preparation for the new realignment over the Green Overbridge later in the year.

We will be working 24/7 during these works.

What to expect

The works will continue 24/7 during the road closures. Access to properties, Stoneleigh Park, will be maintained throughout the works. There will be no pedestrian access during the works. A fully signed diversion will be in place.






HS2/BBV Drop-in events near you
