What are we doing?

Between Thorpe Mandeville and Culworth we have been building the Lower Thorpe viaduct. Earlier this summer, the Lower Thorpe viaduct was launched over Banbury Lane. We are now progressing with the concrete works for the deck structure.

We will be erecting a travelling platform that will move from the southern end of the viaduct, northwards as the deck concreting work progresses along the viaduct.

Whilst we complete these activities above the road, to ensure the safety of road users, short closures of Banbury Lane are required. During November and December, there will be a number of short road closures whilst we complete this work. The expected dates are listed below.

A signed diversion will be in place using the Greatworth Temporary Road.

When will these works take place?

24 hours from 6am on the first day to 8pm on last day of the closure

- POSTPONED Monday 3 November to Wednesday 5 November
- NEW DATES Monday 10 November to Wednesday 12 November
- Monday 24 November to Sunday 30 November

The following dates are subject to change based upon the construction schedule and weather. Updates will be made to this notification online and at the roadside date boards.

- Wednesday 10 December to Friday 19 December

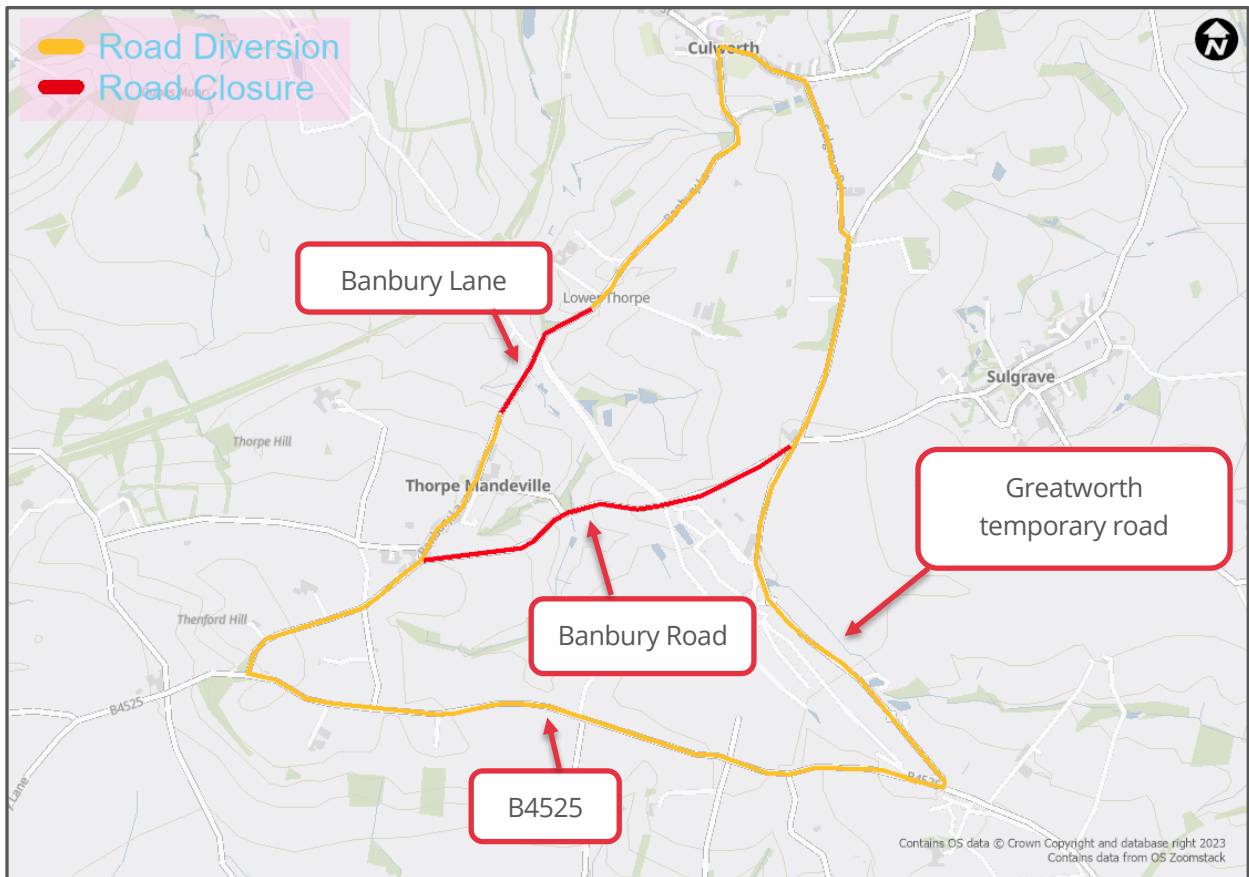
