Update - Road closure of Breakspear Road South for conveyor bridge removal

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

What we are doing

We wrote to you recently to let you know that we would be carrying out works from 3 October to 5 October 2025 for the removal of the conveyor bridge over Breakspear Road South, located between the Chiltern Railway bridge and the HS2 Breakspear Road South bridge.

These works have now been rescheduled, and we will be starting works from **8pm on 28 November to 8pm on 30 November 2025**.

We will dismantle the conveyor bridge in sections using an excavator before lifting them out with a crane and transporting the sections off site on lorries. These works will be carried out 24/7 over a whole weekend.

These works need to be carried out under rail possession, and a full road closure will be required for the duration of these works.

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How these works will affect you

From 8pm Friday 28 November to 8pm Sunday 30 November 2025, to ensure the safety of our staff and the public, the following will apply during the removal of the conveyor bridge:

- **Full road closure of Breakspear Road South from south of the Chiltern Railway bridge to north of the HS2 bridge on Breakspear Road South.**
- **Full closure of the pedestrian crossing for the Celandine Route diversion.**

A clearly signposted diversion route will be in place via Swakeleys Road B467/ High Road B466/ Ickenham Road/ High Street/ Bury Street A4180/ Breakspear Road.

The closure of the diverted Celandine Route will be also clearly signposted, on Breakspear Road South on both sides of the road closure, and on the diverted footpath south of the Chiltern Railway.

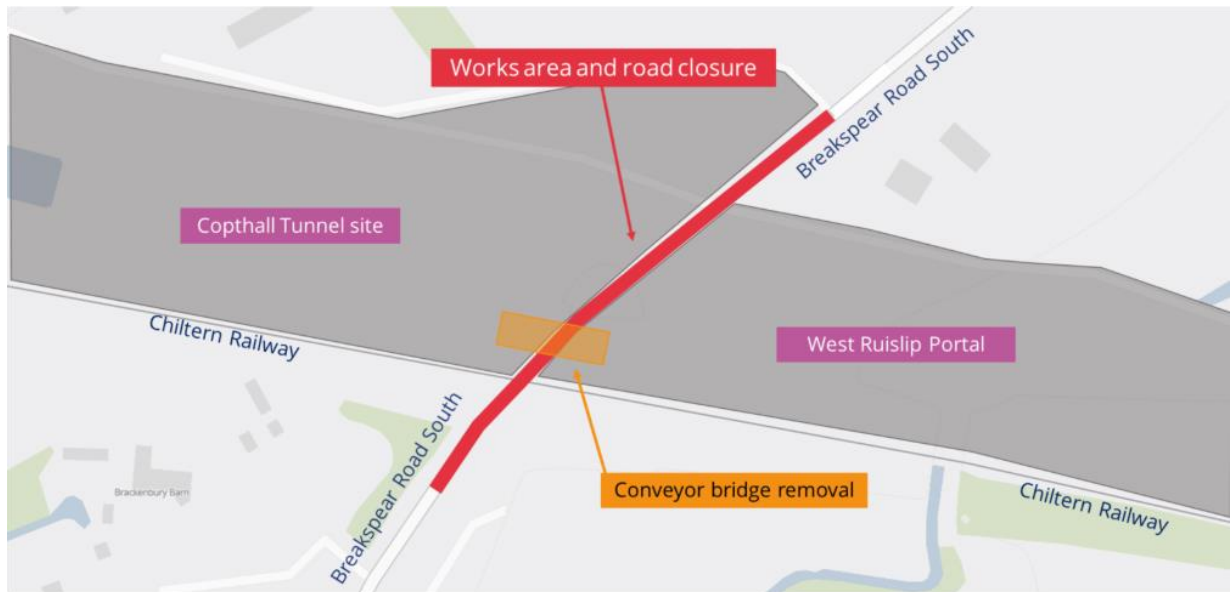
Local access to residential properties will be maintained either side of the road closure, however, **there will be no through access for:**

- Emergency services
- Cyclists
- Vehicles
- Pedestrians

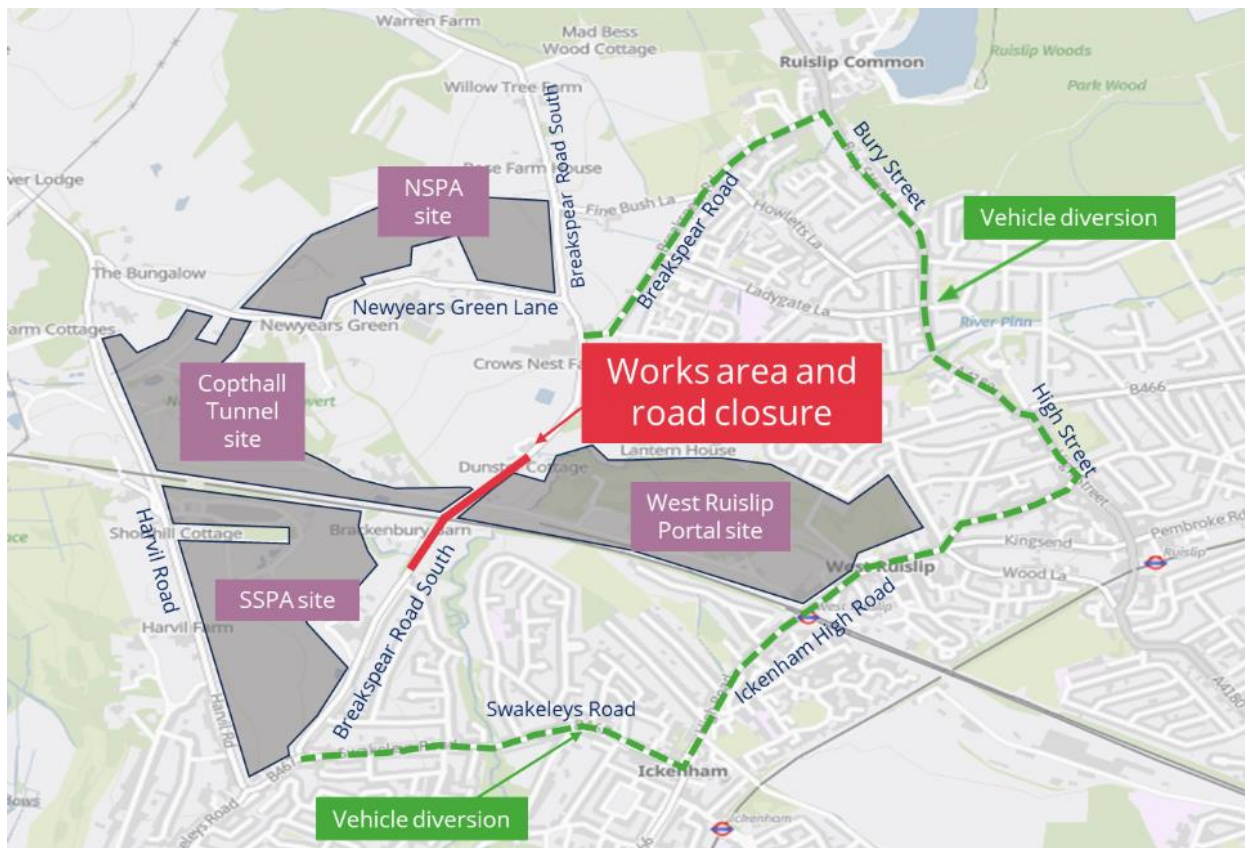
We will monitor noise, dust, and vibration throughout these works to ensure levels remain within agreed limits.

We would like to apologise for any disruption or inconvenience these works may cause. Every effort is being taken to ensure that these works are carried out in the least impactful way. We will ensure that disruption is kept to a minimum.
