

## Additional information

The newly constructed Aston Church Road bridge was originally expected to reopen to vehicles and pedestrians in December 2025.

As previously communicated, the road closure had to be extended due to the need to divert additional uncharted utilities that we had not anticipated encountering. This extended the closure to 25 January 2026.

I am pleased to confirm that we still expect to meet this date for reopening Aston Church Road. The road will remain closed until 25 January and will reopen ready for 26 January 2026. However, we have been unable to complete the remaining works on the short section of Arley Road, adjacent to Masjid Ali. This section will need to remain closed for approximately three weeks.
