We are continuing to carry out assessments on the Marston Box Structure which was constructed on the M42 near junction 9 to allow the new HS2 railway to pass over the motorway and head north.

We will be carrying out a CCTV inspection of utilities alongside the motorway.

Single lane and hard shoulder lane closures.

Some low-level noise will be generated during working hours.


We will be closing the hard shoulder and installing a single lane closure on the M42, overnight, between **9pm** and **5am** on the following dates:
