

Notice of A41 overnight road closures

HS2-EKFB-25-1509

Location

Blackgrove Road north, A41 Bicester Road and the old Bicester Road

Duration

5 nights from Monday 12 January to Saturday 17 January 2026, with each closure lasting from 8:30pm to 5:30am. The final closure will be lifted at 5:30am on Saturday 17 January.

What we are doing

We will be completing the installation of permanent road signage on and around the realigned A41 Bicester Road near Waddesdon and Fleet Marston.

What to expect

Overnight closures of Blackgrove Road north, A41 Bicester Road and the Old Bicester Road. This will include the Waddesdon and Blackgrove Road roundabouts and the A41 overbridge. There will be no access to Waddesdon via the Waddesdon Hill junction with Bicester Road. Signposted diversion routes will be in place.

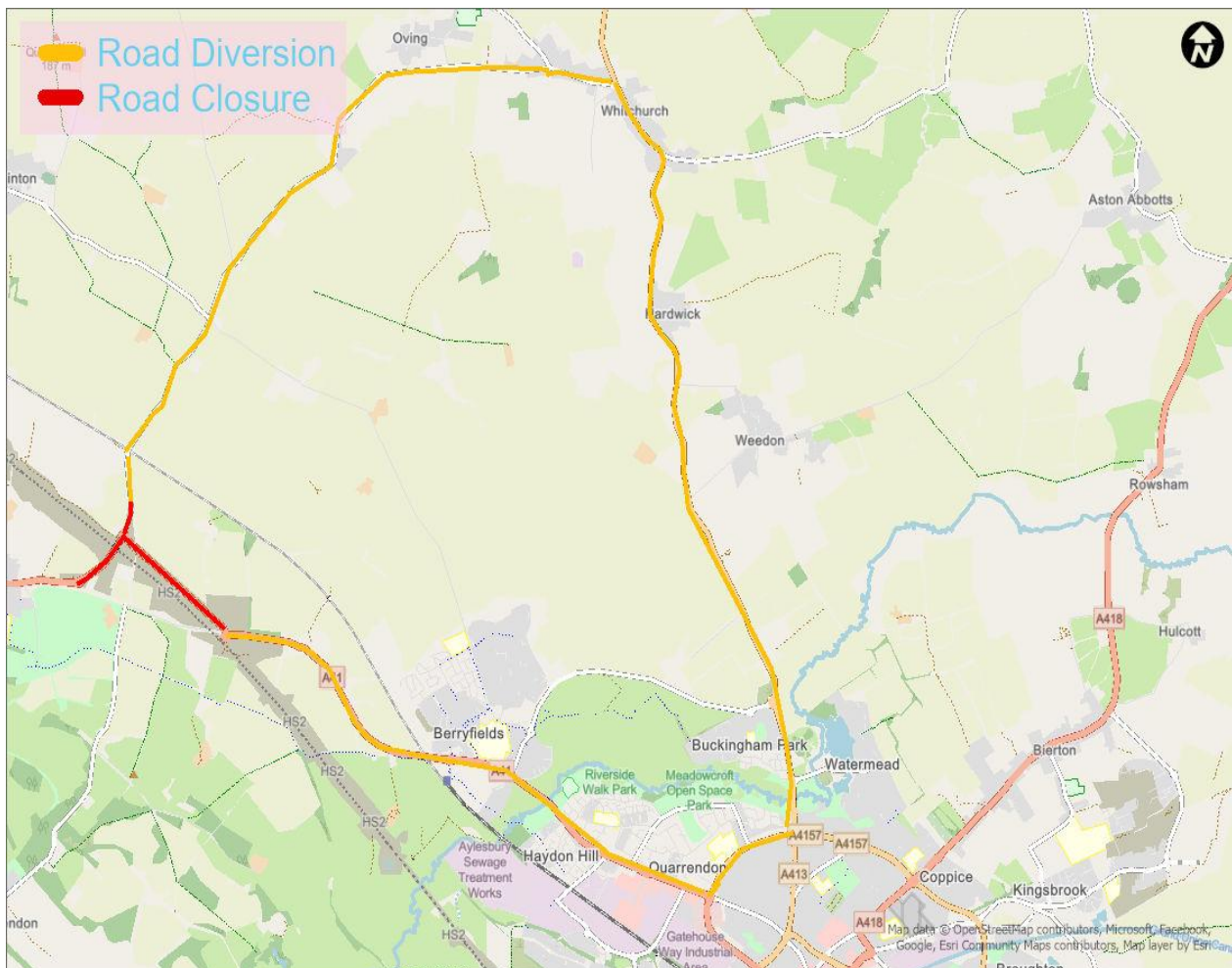
During the works, several teams will carry out tasks at different locations along Blackgrove Road, the A41 Bicester Road and the old Bicester Road simultaneously, moving from one area to the next. For example, concrete post foundations may be installed in one area, while a lifting operation is carried out in another area. These operations require a safety exclusion zone. For these reasons, the works must be carried out under full road closures rather than single lane closures.

We began the signage installation in October using a programme of staggered road closures. We have condensed this works programme into the shortest possible duration, over 5 nights to avoid prolonged disruption for road users. Access for residents who live within the road closures and for emergency services will be maintained.

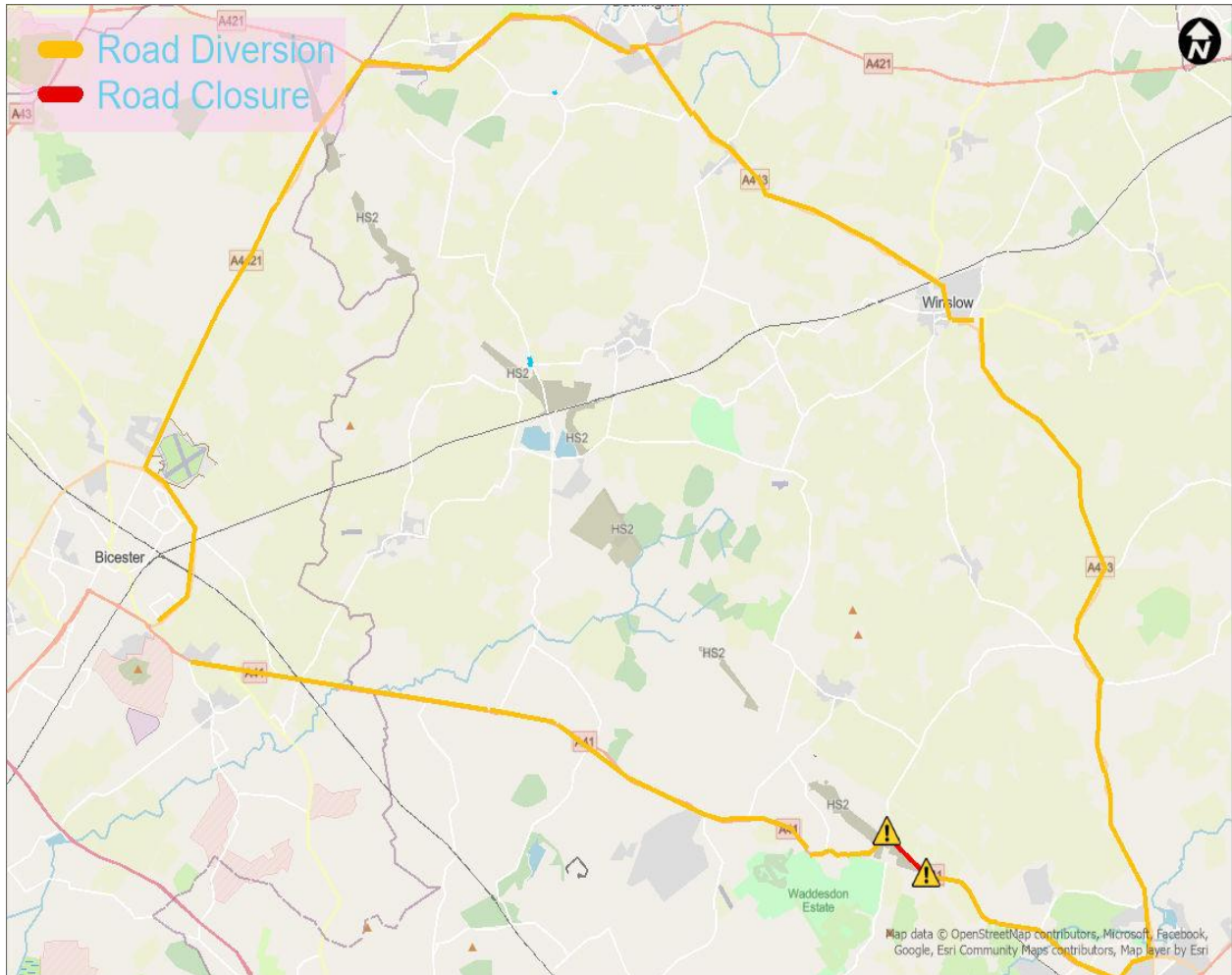
