West Ruislip Portal, porous portal and headhouse construction site

Duration

Saturday 14 February, 8am to 1pm

This work needs to be completed at the weekend as it cannot be carried out alongside other works due to the small size of the area.

What we are doing

We need to hydro scabble at the roof level of the headhouse. An acoustic structure will be in place around the work to minimise noise.

What to expect

There will be periods of increased noise while we carry out this work.

Workers may be visible above the hoarding.



Hydro scabbling involves using high-pressure water jets to scratch the concrete surfaces and help new layers stick. We have previously been breaking the concrete by hand but this area cannot be reached with these tools.
