Cable diversion works on Badminton Close and Mandeville Road, Northolt

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

What we are doing

From **5 January to 3 March 2026**, we will be diverting power cables on Badminton Close and on Mandeville Road.

We will be digging trenches on Badminton Close from 5 January to 12 February 2026. We will work in phases, starting at the Mandeville Road junction and moving towards the garages at the end of Badminton Close.

From 29 January to 12 February 2026, we will be digging trenches on Mandeville Road.

As the works progress, we will put ducting into the trenches and refill them.

From 13 February to 3 March 2026, we will pull the new cables through the ducting.

How this may affect you

During the Mandeville Road works, there will be a lane and footpath closure from the site entrance as far as Badminton Close. Bus stop B will be suspended. There will be a pedestrian diversion.

We will be using excavators and handheld concrete breakers. You may hear some additional noise. We will use noise reducing barriers where possible.

There will be parking bay suspensions on Badminton Close. Vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained. We will have a welfare unit parked nearby.


