Restart of works in Euston Approaches

We are now restarting all works in Euston Approaches. In 2026, we'll start planning works that were previously deferred as a result of the pause in Euston. A broad overview of all our upcoming works is provided below.

Parkway utility works – February to September 2026

We need to protect and divert utility services beneath Parkway junction and in the surrounding area before we begin tunnelling. From February to September, we'll carry out utility works on the sewers, water mains and power cables on Parkway, Albert Street and Delancey Street. Please see notice [here](#) for detailed phasing. In autumn 2026, we'll return to Parkway to complete protective works to the Cadent Gas main. We'll provide more information on these works closer to the time.

Easter bank holiday 24-hour works (day and night) – 3 to 8 April 2026

We plan our construction activities to avoid working over the holidays wherever possible, but for safety reasons we can only carry out certain works next to the railway when the tracks are not in use. From **8am Friday 3 April**, to **8pm Wednesday 8 April** we will work **24 hours, day and night** to complete the work below:

- We'll begin sheet piling in the Euston Throat work site. You may notice brief periods of noise while we install the piles. We'll minimise noise impacts where possible and continually monitor noise levels to ensure we're working within the approved limits.
- In Camden Cutting North, we'll install concrete support structures, known as L-units close to the Network Rail tracks. We'll lift the L-units via the lorry lay-by on Park Village East into site using the tower crane and secure them into place.
- We'll install instrumentation and monitoring equipment, and carry out regular surveys and maintenance of the bridges, gantries, tunnels and structures within the railway cutting, to inform and assess the impact of our works.

Please note, Network Rail will also be doing essential track maintenance over this period. You may notice an increase in noise levels during this period as a result of these works.

Preparatory works in Zone 5 on Hampstead Road - 1 April to December 2026

We need to extend Hampstead Road bridge to pass over the newly excavated and extended railway cutting. We'll build a temporary road to the east of Hampstead Road, over the area known as Zone 5 to maintain uninterrupted traffic flows on Hampstead Road.

From **1 April**, we'll start setting up the site by installing our site office and welfare building with connections to mains power. We'll prepare the area for piling by removing a section of the polymer plant within our existing site, compacting the area and moving out our hoarding on Hampstead Road. To facilitate this hoarding move, we'll relocate bus stop W on Hampstead Road approximately 80m north, closer to Amphill Estate.

We'll install piles throughout Zone 5, to support the temporary road which will be in place for approximately two years. During the construction of the temporary road and the extension of the bridge, we'll need to fully close Hampstead Road on three occasions, with each closure lasting approximately four weeks. The first closure is currently planned for winter 2026/27. We'll engage with local businesses, residents and the wider community well in advance of these closures. Works in Camden Cutting – Ongoing till winter 2026

In the Camden Cutting area of our site, we are strengthening and protecting the Network Rail retaining wall ahead of major excavations beginning in 2027. These works will continue until winter 2026. We'll also restart works at track-level to build the foundations and other support structures for the Euston Scissor Box. We'll notify you of any impactful works nearer the time.

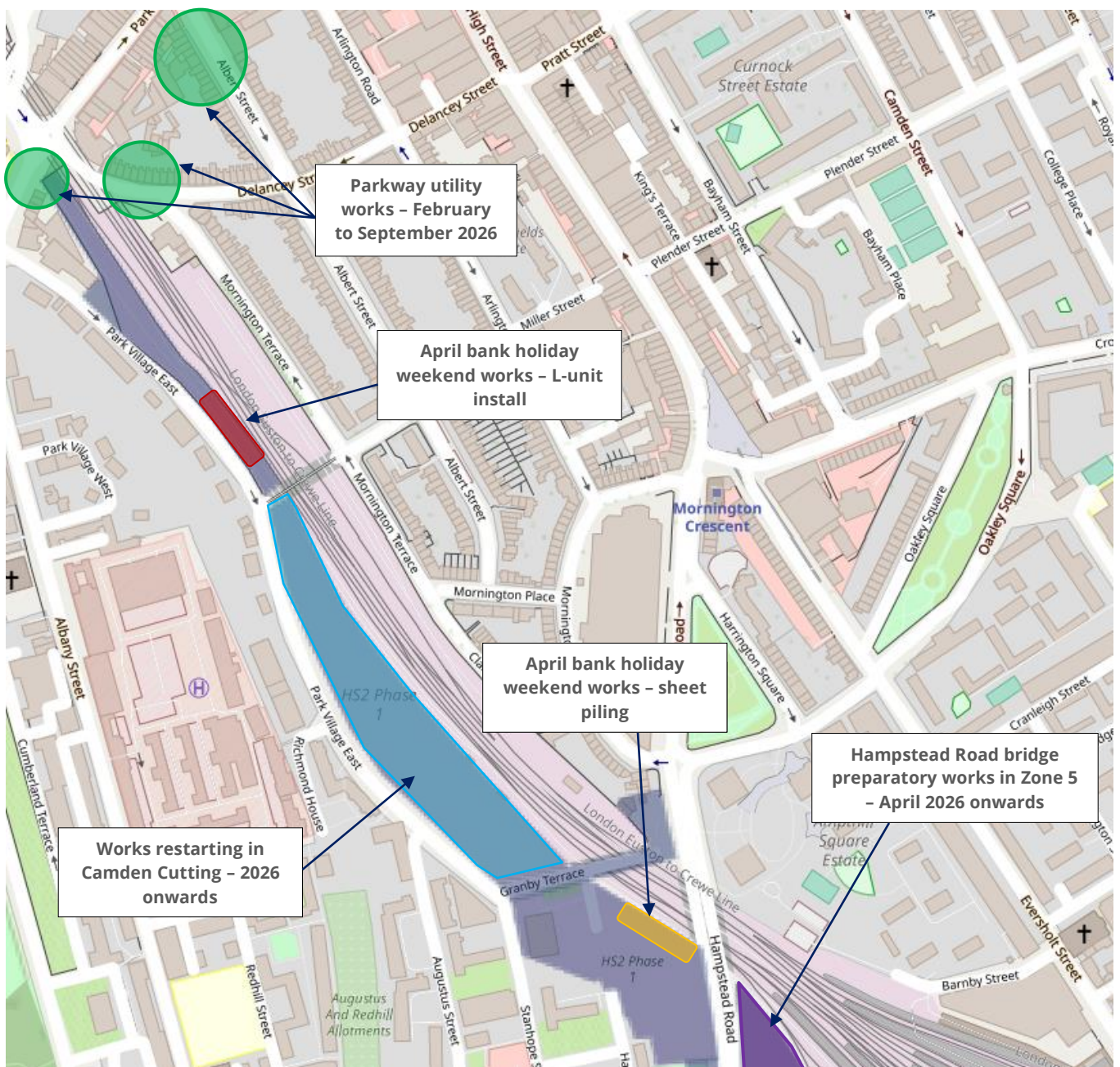
Hampstead Road utility works – Ongoing till April 2026
