## **Footpath and lane closures on Hampstead Road and Lidlington Place – February to March**

We will continue our programme of utility diversion works on Hampstead Road and Lidlington Place in preparation for the Hampstead Road bridge extension works. We previously installed a new cable route from Lidlington Place to Varndell Street via Granby Terrace, to replace the existing route next to Hampstead Road. Now that we have installed the ducting which will form the cable route, we are currently pulling the cables through the pipes between underground cable joint bays located on the route.

We previously informed you we would carry out these works on Hampstead Road near Ampthill estate from 5 January to 6 February. These works were delayed, and will now start on 2 February. We will close the footpath and nearside lane, and pedestrians will be diverted around the closure. We will maintain access to Ampthill estate at all times. We will use the same traffic management to carry out trial holes in this area to inform our utility works design when we return utilities back onto Hampstead Road following the bridge extension. We expect to complete these works by 31 March.

From 9 February till 31 March, we will close a lane on Lidlington Place near Eversholt Street and install temporary traffic lights at the junction for cable pulling works. The pedestrian crossings will be maintained.

## **Footpath and lane closure on Hampstead Road near Cardington Street – Ongoing till 27 February**

We previously informed you of utility diversion works on Hampstead Road south of Cardington Street. These works were due to be complete on 6 February. Due to a clash with Mace Dragados JV hoarding works, we will now complete these works on 27 February. We will close the southbound lane on Hampstead Road near Cardington Street. The footpath on Hampstead Road near Cardington Street will be closed, and pedestrians will be diverted through the carriageway and worksite.

We are also working in the eastern footpath and southbound lane on Hampstead Road near Varndell Street. We were due to finish these works by 6 February however we will now complete them on 16 February.


We are due to complete our works in the northbound lane on Hampstead Road near Varndell Street by 2 February. Once these works are complete, we will open Varndell Street.
