
#### **Additional information**

We will be working above the railway in December and working overnight on and above the road in January to facilitate crane operations. During these works, cranes will be used to lift the parapets onto the viaduct, requiring full closures of both the railway and the road on the respective dates listed above.

Please note, dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control but will be completed on or around the timings specified.
