# Update Notice of road closure, Radstone Road, Radstone

## What are we doing?

We sincerely apologise for the inconvenience and thank you for your understanding and patience as we work to ensure the road is safe to reopen.

Following a road safety audit (23 December), the reopening of Radstone Road and overbridge has been delayed. Whilst works have been completed, the auditor has confirmed that the transition between the old and new sections of highway is not yet compliant. Further detailed assessments will take place in the new year, and the road closure has been extended until mid-February 2026 in order to address these issues.

We will provide an update to local communities in the new year once we have confirmed programme dates.

**The road remains open on the old alignment for pedestrians and cyclists, however we ask cyclists to dismount when travelling through the works area.**

## When will these works take place?

A section of Radstone Road will be closed, with signed diversion in place, on the following dates:

- Monday 3 November 2025 up to **Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> February 2026**

These works may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control. We will update communities in advance.


