

Notice of A418 Oxford Road Traffic Management

HS2-EKFB-26-1616

Location

A418 Oxford Road, between Coldharbour roundabout and Stone, opposite EKFB A418 compound site entrance.

Duration

11 days, Monday 23 February to Thursday 5 March.

What we are doing

We will be replacing the current mobile traffic lights, with fixed traffic lights on the A418 EKFB site entrance for the duration of the HS2 works.

What to expect

10 days, Monday 23 February to Wednesday 4 March, lane closure, 4 way temporary traffic lights, off peak 9.30am to 3pm.

1 night, Wednesday 4 March to Thursday 5 March, overnight road closure, 8.30pm to 5.30am, with associated diversion route.

The current mobile traffic lights on the A418 will remain in place during the work to install the new fixed traffic lights. There will be an **off peak lane closure (9.30am to 3pm)** with 4 way temporary traffic lights being set up and taken down each day.


When the 4 way temporary lights have been taken down, the current mobile traffic lights system will remain operational.

There will be a single overnight road closure at the end of the works, to remove the current mobile traffic lights and switch on the new fixed traffic lights at this location.

The map below shows the location of the off peak lane closure, with the associated 4 way temporary traffic lights opposite the EKFB compound site:


9.30am to 3pm, Monday 23 February to Wednesday 4 March (10 days)
