Radstone Road, Radstone.

Duration

We would like to update you on the current closure. To complete the final remedial works, the road closure has been extended until **mid-April 2026**.

What we are doing

We are continuing works to complete the overbridge and finalise the new road alignment. This includes delivering the necessary improvements highlighted through our road safety audits, as well as undertaking some adjustment works at the western tie-in. What to expect

A full road closure 24 hours a day on a section of Radstone Road between Brackley and Helmdon.

The road remains open on the old alignment for pedestrians and cyclists; however, we ask cyclists to dismount when travelling through the works area.
