The Euston Tunnel will carry high-speed trains between London Euston Station and Old Oak Common Station in Ealing

What we are doing

We are building the Euston Tunnel between Old Oak Common and Euston using two tunnel boring machines (TBMs)

What to expect

Some residents living near the Euston Tunnel route may hear some groundborne noise as the TBMs pass, or when we are building cross passages between the tunnels. We will update you as the tunnel construction progresses.

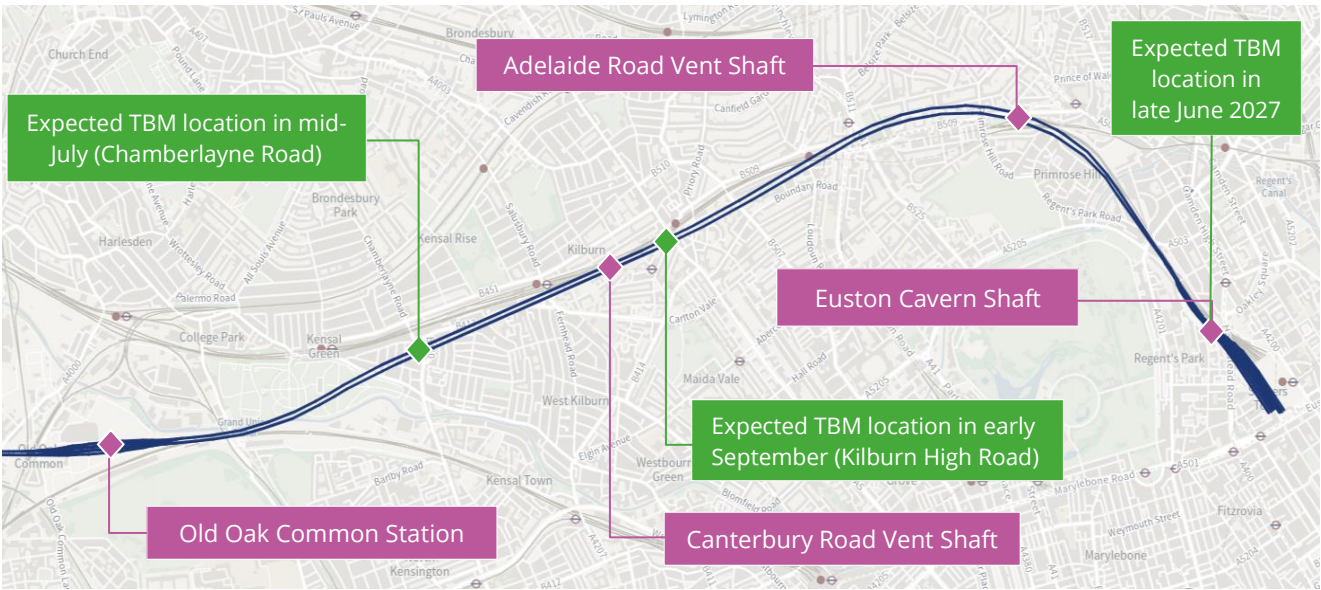

Where we will be working

We expect to launch the first tunnel boring machine (TBM Madeleine) from the Old Oak Common site in week beginning 26 January 2026 for the upline, with the second downline TBM (TBM Karen) launched about a month later. The TBMs will progress up to 150 metres a week. The TBMs are expected to reach Chamberlayne Road, Kensal Green in mid-July 2026, and Kilburn High Road, Kilburn, in early September 2026. The depth from the ground surface to the top of the tunnel in this area varies between 35 and 40 metres. We expect both TBMs to complete their journey to the Euston Cavern by late June 2027.



Additional Information

We are carrying out monitoring and visual surveys along the tunnelling route. You may notice our surveying team in your local area for short periods. We will let you know if any of our monitoring and visual surveys will impact you directly.
