What we are doing

Demolishing three garages, numbers 10, 11 and 12, and building a new site entrance for the Mandeville Road Vent Shaft.

What to expect

Residents may experience noise and vibration as we will be breaking concrete. We will use noise reducing barriers where possible.

Access to the other garages will be maintained.

We will demolish three garages (number 10, 11 and 12), removing the roofs and walls. We will use an excavator and handheld tools such as breakers and saws. We will then construct the site entrance access. Concrete will be delivered to site, poured and compacted with a roller for the ground base. We will then put up new hoardings and site gate.
