We will be installing monitoring equipment at the Hampstead Britannia Hotel to measure ground movement before, during and after tunneling works in the area.

- Temporary road and footpath closures.
- Vehicle and pedestrian diversion
- Parking bay suspensions on Fellows Road outside the hotel.
- Minor disruption to journeys due to road closure.

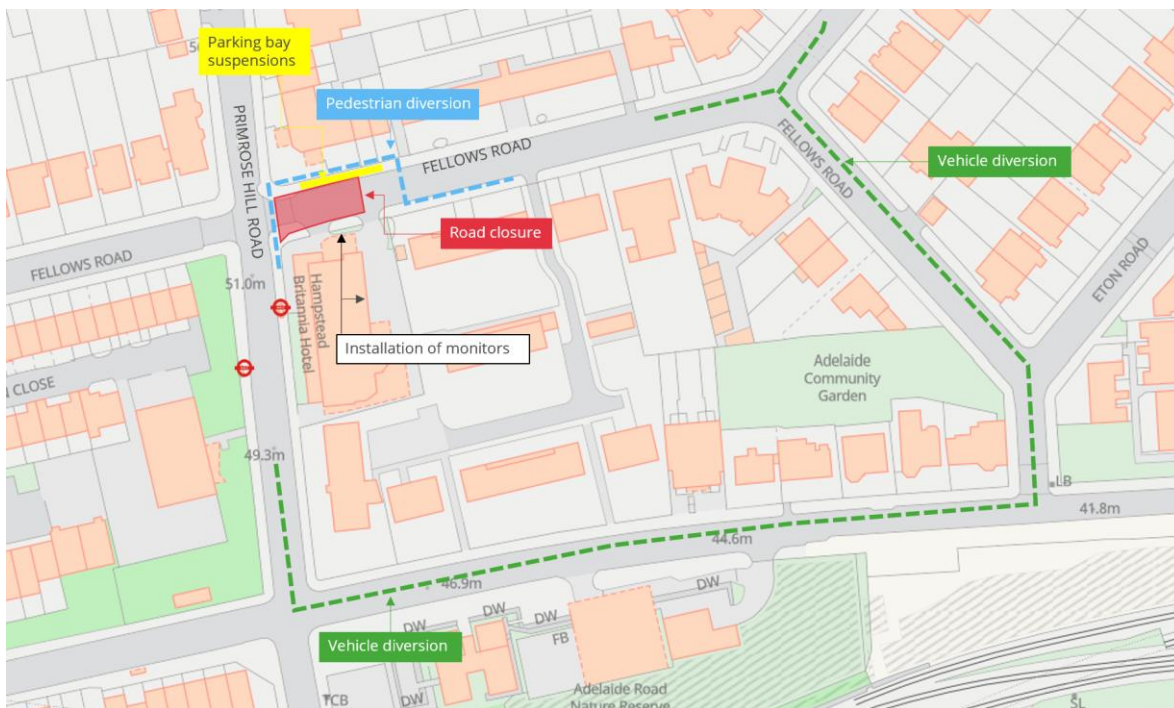
We wrote to you in March 2026 regarding the installation of monitoring equipment at the Hampstead Britannia Hotel to measure ground movement (Ref: HS2-SCS-26-1762). Due to unforeseen factors, we were unable to complete the work. The remaining installations have now been rescheduled for the dates on the previous page.

We will fix the monitoring points onto the hotel building using an elevated mobile platform and handheld power tools. During the work, there will be no vehicle access on Fellows Road up to the junction with Primrose Hill Road. A signed vehicle diversion will be in place via Eton Road and Adelaide Road. Traffic marshals will be in place to assist vehicles accessing the Hampstead Britannia Hotel.
