From **19th January 2026** until approximately **mid-February 2026**.

What we are doing

We will be carrying out ground surveys on Doric Way to locate existing services. This will help us plan and deliver future utility works efficiently. To complete these surveys, sections of the surface will be cut, broken out, and excavated. During this period, five parking bays and one motorcycle bay will be suspended.

What to expect

Working hours are **Monday to Friday, 8:00am to 6:00pm**. Start-up and close-down activities may occur up to one hour before and after these times. Occasionally, work may also take place on Saturdays and Sundays between 8:00am and 6:00pm.



We appreciate your understanding as we carry out these essential works. While some disruption is unavoidable, noise levels may increase at times, particularly during excavation. To help reduce impact, acoustic blankets will be installed, and pedestrian access will remain open throughout. In the coming months, we will undertake building monitoring and surveys at 1-79 Doric Way to support future works.
