

# Notice of road closure, B4102 Meriden Road, Solihull

## Location

Meriden Road, B4102 Solihull

## Duration

We will close Meriden Road from **Monday 23 February 2026** to **Sunday 8 March 2026**. The road closure will be in place between **8am and 6pm** Monday to Friday.

## What we are doing

As part of our ongoing work to construct the River Blythe Viaduct we need to close Meriden Road so that we can install the deck beams. The closure is required so that we can complete our work safely.

## What to expect

**A fully signposted diversion route will be in place throughout the closure.** There will be increased construction activity during the closure, and you will experience some disruption to your travel times. Please plan ahead to avoid delays to your journey.



## Additional information

The closure will be in place between 8am and 6pm, Monday to Friday. If our work progresses well the road will reopen as soon as it is safe to do so. Access to businesses and homes at Patrick Farm will be maintained throughout the closure and pedestrians and cyclists will be escorted safely through the closure. We aim to complete the work within one week but to allow for inclement weather we are closing the road for two weeks. Following the work our cranes will be moved to Truggist Lane for works commencing on Monday 2 March. We will not be closing Meriden Road and Truggist Lane concurrently.

We will need to close Meriden Road again in April and June 2026, so that we can pour concrete to create the bridge deck and install the parapets. Further details will be shared with the community as soon as they are confirmed.
