- Saturday 7 February – Monday 9 February
- Monday 16 February – Saturday 7 March 2026

What we are doing

In February, we will be continuing with construction of the Wendover green tunnel site entrance on the Wendover bypass.

We will also be installing parapets on the Small Dean viaduct, directly above the A413 London Road.

What to expect

- Full weekend road closure of Wendover bypass
- Lane closure with traffic management on the Wendover bypass (contingency)
- Overnight road closures of A413 London Road

Wendover bypass, Wendover green tunnel works - additional information

On the Wendover bypass, we will be completing road surfacing and tie-ins to the road to finalise the construction of the new Wendover green tunnel site entrance. The works will require a weekend road closure on the Wendover bypass. There are contingency weekends planned in the event that we are not able to complete the works in one weekend, due to reasons such as adverse weather.

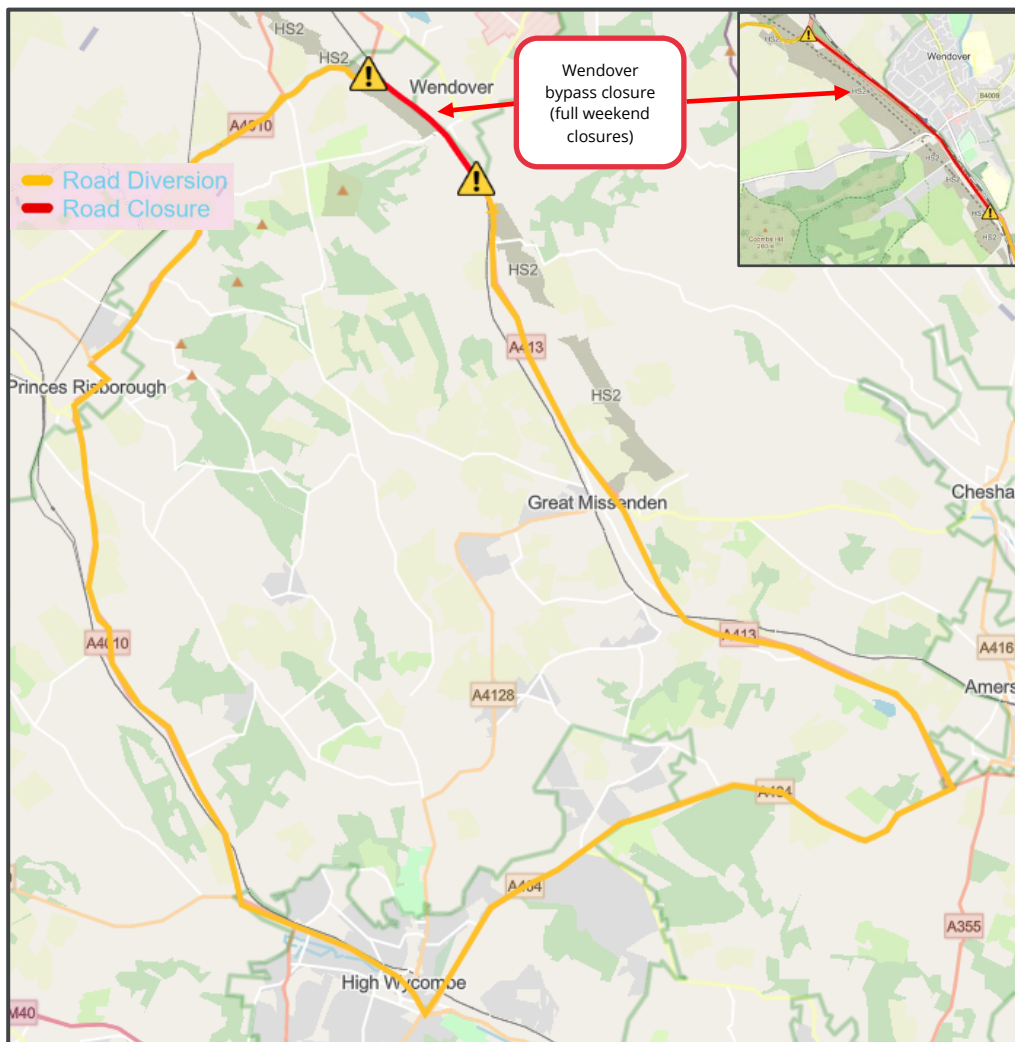
Where we will be working

We will be working on the bypass and in the layby leading up to the Wendover green tunnel. The diversion route for when the road is closed is shown in the map below.

Dates of closures

Weekend road closures of Wendover bypass:

- Saturday 7 February (6:00am) – Monday 9 February (6:00am)



***Please note, dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control but will be completed within the timings specified.**

Wendover bypass - Wendover green tunnel works (contingency lane closure)

Following the completion of the Wendover green tunnel site entrance works between 7 – 9 February, the new road will require a road safety audit. Should there be any remedial work required following the audit, there will be a lane closure with two-way traffic management on the Wendover bypass.

Consent has been granted by the council to allow for work to continue outside normal working hours. Some noise may be observable while we undertake this construction.

Where we will be working

We will be working on the A413 Wendover Bypass and in the layby leading up to the Wendover green tunnel north portal entrance.

Dates of lane closure (contingency)

Weekend lane closure, two-way traffic management on Wendover bypass (8:00am – 5pm):

- Saturday 21 February - Sunday 22 February



A413 London Road, Small Dean Viaduct works – additional information

Following the parapet installation on the Small Dean Viaduct during the Christmas period, we will be continuing with parapet installation over the A413. During these works, cranes will be used to lift the parapets onto the viaduct, requiring overnight closures of the road.

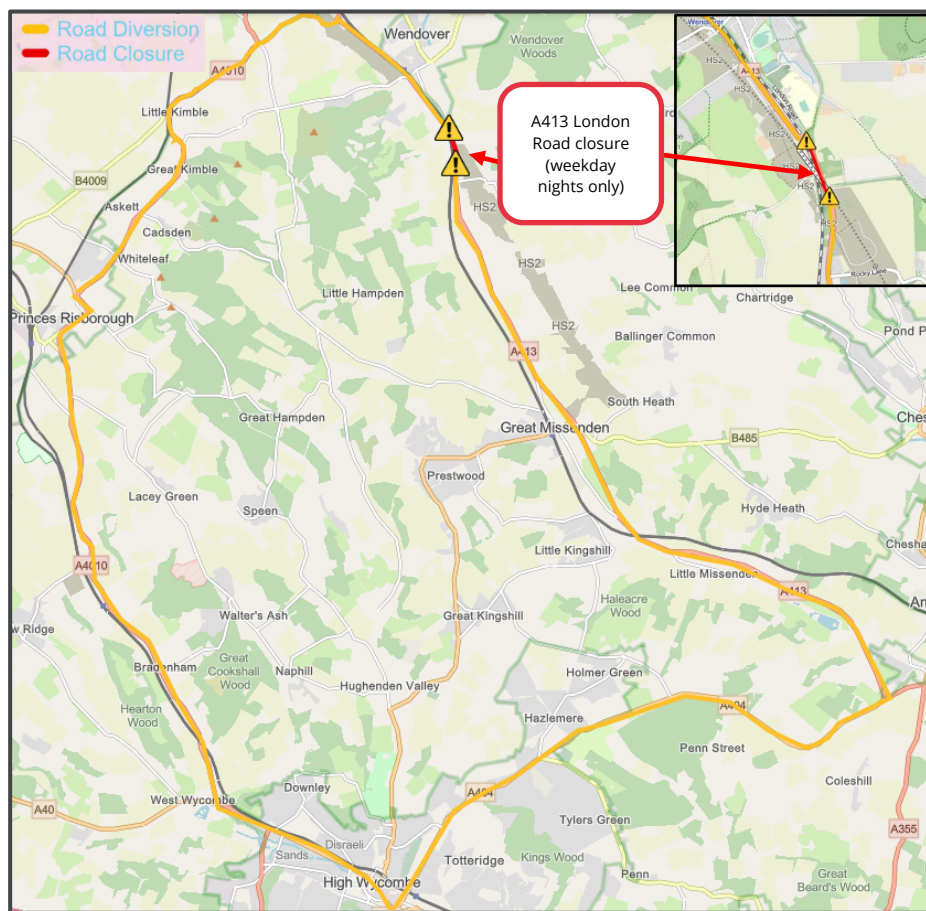
Where we will be working

We will be working under the viaduct on the A413 London Road. The diversion route for when the road is closed is shown in the map below.

Dates of closures

Overnight road closures of A413 London Road (8:30pm- 5:30am):

- Monday 16 February – Saturday 21 February
- Monday 23 February - Saturday 28 February
- Monday 2 March – Saturday 7 March
