

Where we will be working

We will be working along a section of Boddington Road, from Three Shires Farm to Spella House.

The map below shows the road closure location and the suggested local diversion route. **Please note;** there are 3-tonne weight limits on both the canal bridge on Claydon Road and railway bridge on Fenny Compton Road to Claydon village, as well as a 4.4-metre (14 foot 6 inches) height restriction under the railway bridge on Mollington Road. Please plan your journey accordingly.
