# Update - Utility works around Parkway – February to October 2026

Parkway, Albert Street and Delancey Street

### **Parkway utility works – February to October**

We need to protect and divert utility services beneath Parkway junction and in the surrounding area before the tunnel boring machine passes beneath. From February we started our utility works on the sewers, water mains and power cables on Parkway, Albert Street and Delancey Street. We expect to complete these works in October 2026.

In autumn 2026, we'll return to Parkway to complete protective works to the Cadent Gas main.

### **Utility works (UKPN cable route) on Delancey Street and Parkway – 16 March to July**

We'll continue to divert a section of the UK Power Networks cable route on Delancey Street and Parkway. We'll carry out the work in phases on Parkway and Delancey Street. We'll require lane and footpath closures and parking bay suspensions in these areas. We've experienced delays to the programme due to the need to install additional cable ducts on Delancey St.

We'll close a section of the southbound lane and footpath on Parkway, close to the junction with Park Village East. These works are being carried out in two phases in this area. The first phase was completed on 16 May. We'll return on **15 June** to complete the second phase which we expect will take 6 weeks to complete. **There will be no right-turn from Parkway onto Prince Albert Road.** Traffic will be diverted via Gloucester Avenue, Regents Park Road and St. Marks Square.

We'll continue works on the southern section of Delancey Street west of Mornington Terrace, we expect these works to be completed by **26 May**.

We'll then switch to the northern lane on Delancey Street on **26 May**. We expect these works to be complete by late July. We'll continue to suspend the bus stop. Passengers will need to use bus stop CT on Delancey Street between Albert Street and Arlington Road.

We apologise for the inconvenience these works may cause. Please see map on next page for current works and tentative dates for future phases. We'll provide you with an update once dates for these phases are confirmed.

### **Utility trial holes (gas main) – 26 May to 12 June**

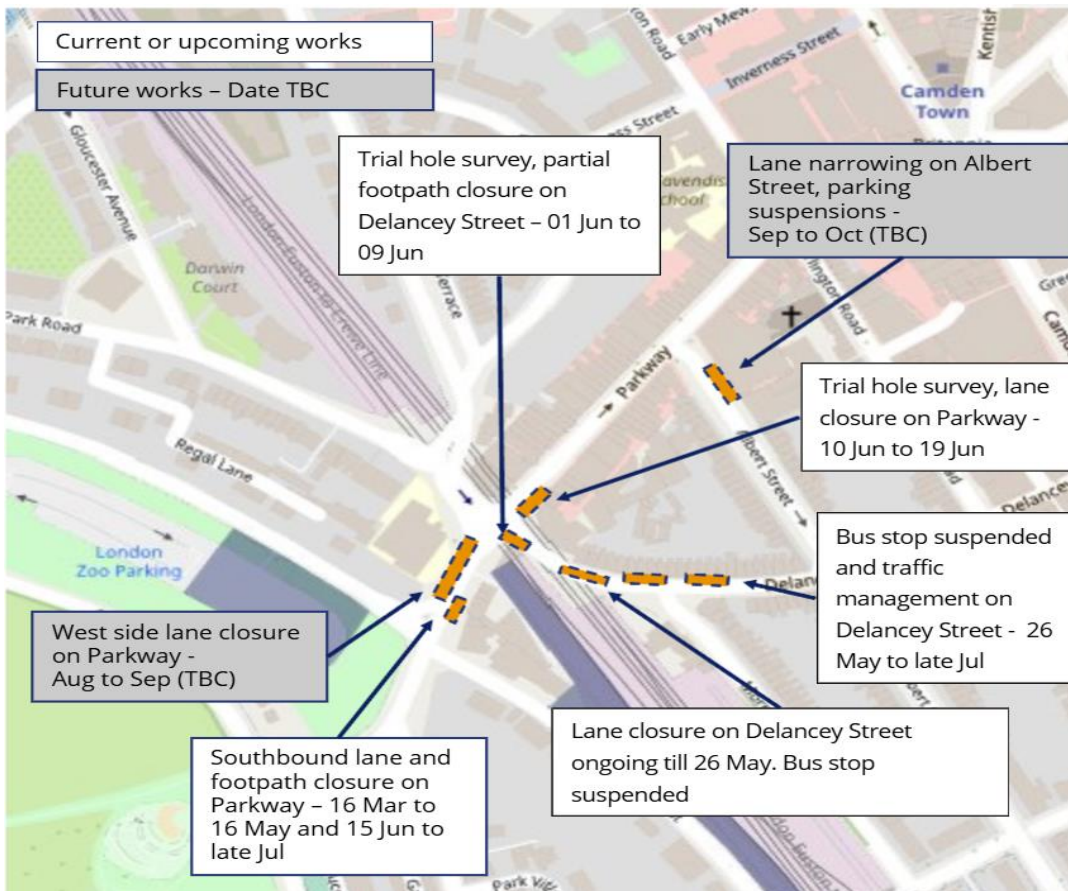
On **1 June** we'll carry out trial hole surveys in the southern footpath on Delancey Street close to the junction of Parkway. We'll provide sufficient space on the footpath for pedestrians. We expect these works to be complete by 9 June.

On **10 June** we'll carry out trial hole surveys on Parkway. We'll close a lane and partially close the footpath on Parkway north of Delancey Street and dig a trial hole, carry out the survey and reinstate the area. We expect these works to be complete by 19 June.

The installation and removal of traffic management (TM) on the highway is subject to 24hrs/7-days working arrangements to allow for maintenance and any necessary changes to the traffic management setup.

This is also a safety requirement to ensure the work can be carried out safely and efficiently during these periods.
