Footpath and lane closures on Hampstead Road - 2 to 13 March

We are continuing our utility diversion works in the southern section of Hampstead Road in preparation for the Hampstead Road bridge extension works. From 2 to 13 March, we will close the southbound lane on Hampstead Road north and south of Cardington Street, and we fully close Varndell Street. Vehicle access to Regent's Park Estate will be via Robert Street. Our traffic management will be set out overnight on 1 March.

Footpath and lane closures on Hampstead Road and Lidlington Place – February to March

Works by utility service provider in Euston Approaches


We previously informed you that the next phase of the utility diversion works involves various utility service providers working within our site, as well as on Hampstead Road, Lidlington Place and Stanhope Street to complete the final connections and energise their networks. As part of these works, from **16 March to 24 April**, UK Power Networks will be working in the northbound carriageway and the northbound footpath on Hampstead Road. The northbound lane and footpath will be closed, with pedestrians diverted across to the eastern footpath. For more information on these works, please see our previous notice [here](#).
