

# Installation of monitoring equipment on Kilburn Priory, Camden

Kilburn Priory, Camden

### What we are doing

We will be installing monitoring equipment into the ground under the footway on Kilburn Priory. This equipment will allow us to accurately measure and monitor any ground movement before, during and after the tunneling works in the area.

### What to expect

- A footway closure and pedestrian diversion on Kilburn Priory
- A northbound lane closure on Kilburn Priory between Springfield Lane and Mortimer Place
- One of the entrances to Goldsmiths Place will be closed (shown on the map on the next page)
- Parking bay suspensions

### Additional information


We will be digging two holes to install the monitoring equipment below ground level. Access to properties will be maintained. There will be a 3-way temporary traffic light system, with marshals to help with traffic flow.

You may hear some noise from breaking concrete. Where possible, we will use noise reducing barriers. Once the installation of the equipment is complete, we will reinstate the footway and northbound lane.

We apologise for any inconvenience this work may cause.
