Update: Tree trimming on Victoria Road, North Acton

Location

Victoria Road, North Acton, between Dudding Hill Bridge and Chandos Road

Duration

Thursday 12 and Friday 13 March 2026
10am to 3pm

What we are doing

We will be trimming trees along the raised footpath on Victoria Road. These works are required to ensure the safe removal on the HS2 conveyor bridge later in the year.

What to expect

You may hear some noise from power tools while we trim back branches.

There will be a temporary footpath closure on Victoria Road from Midland Terrace to just past Chandos Road, with a signed pedestrian diversion in place.

A southbound lane on Victoria Road will also be closed between Dudding Hill Bridge and the mini roundabout at Chandos Road.

Additional information

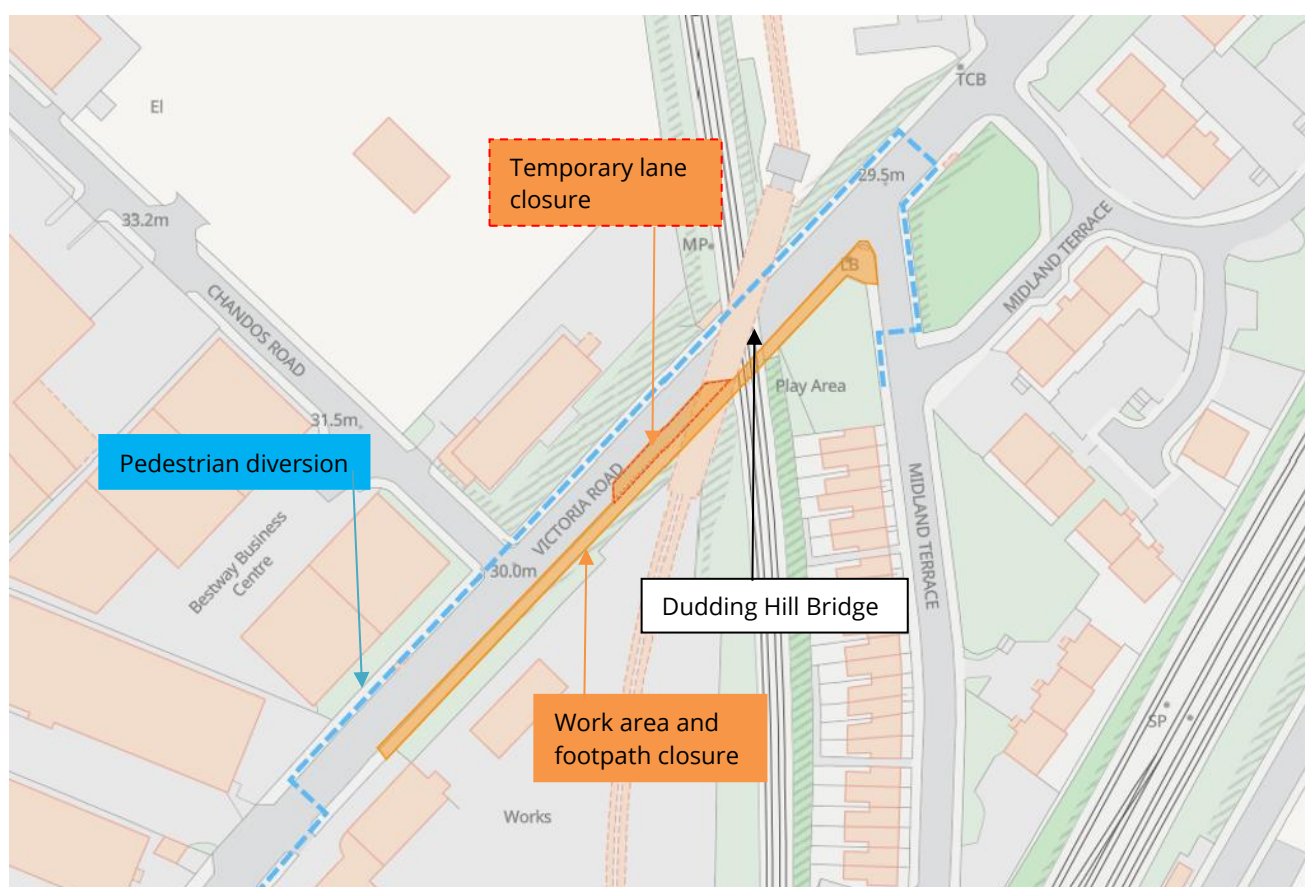
We wrote to you in February 2026 regarding the tree trimming works on Victoria Road. Unfortunately, this work did not take place due to unforeseen circumstances. We have now rescheduled the works for the dates on the previous page.

During the work, we will have traffic marshals with stop and go boards in place to keep vehicles moving safely. We don't expect any significant traffic delays.

The southbound bike lane will also be suspended while the work takes place.
