

# Notice of road closure on Watton Lane for resurfacing works

Watton Lane, Water Orton

- Tuesday 28 April 2026

### What we are doing

We recently resurfaced a section of Watton Lane as part of the A446 Lichfield Road closure. We are continuing this work, and we will fully resurface the rest of Watton Lane from the mini roundabout at Maud Road, past Gypsy Lane, under the M6 Toll, to the junction with Gilson Road.

Once finished, this new section will link seamlessly with the resurfacing we've already completed.

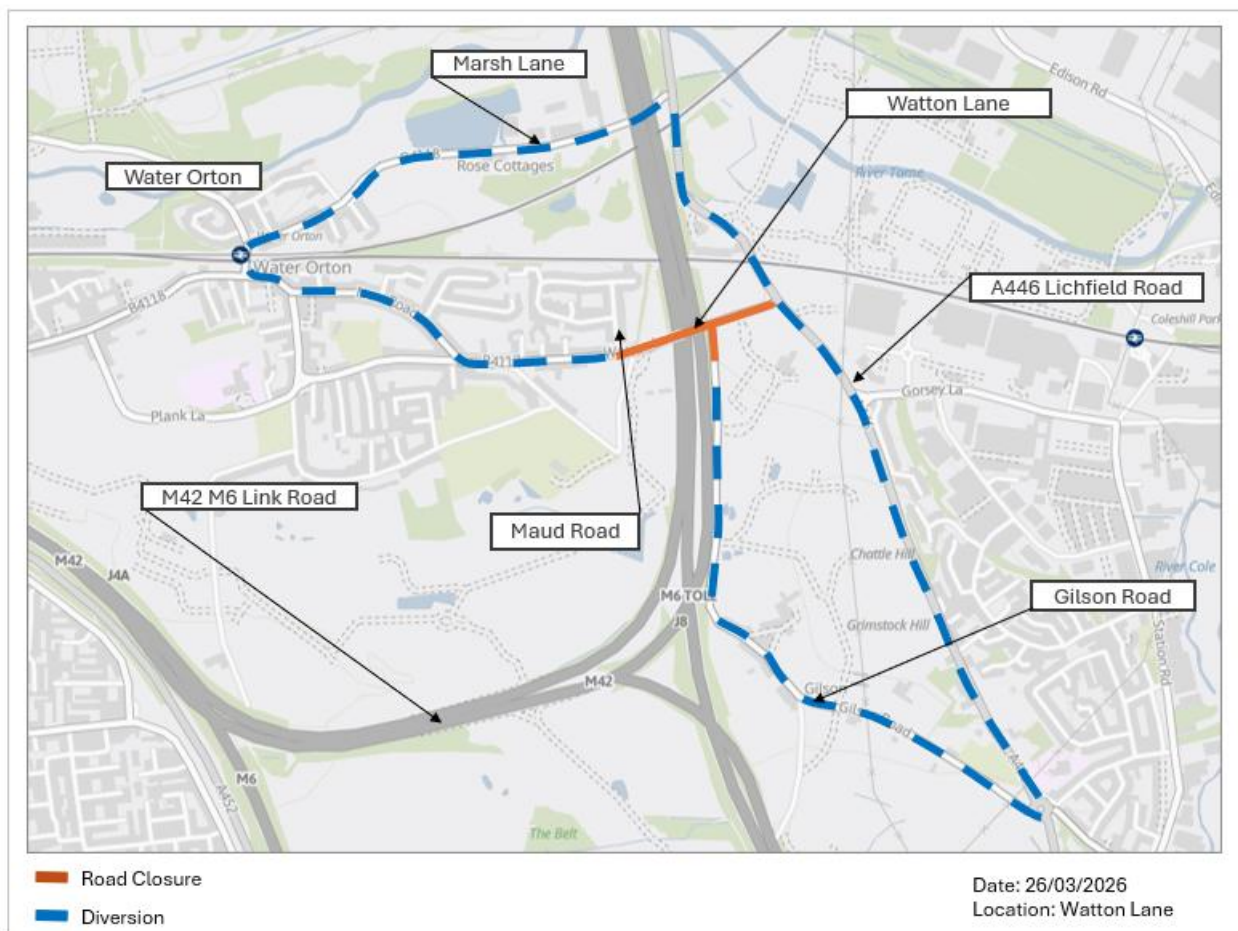

## What to expect

- Works will commence at the Maud Road junction and progress towards the Gilson Road junction to minimise disruption to residents.
- Resurfacing preparations will take place during the first two night-time closures (Monday 27 – Tuesday 28 April)
- The final two planned night-time closures will be used to complete the road resurfacing (Wednesday 29 – Thursday 30 April)
- When the road reopens during daytime hours, exposed ironworks (drainage covers) will be present as part of the preparation for the new road surface.
