

# Notice of road closure Werner Terrace/Brackley Lane, Calvert

**HS2-EKFB-26-1729**

## Location

Werner Terrace/Brackley Lane junction, Calvert Green

## Duration

16 March until 11 April 2026, 24 hours a day

## What we are doing

The works involve removing a 30m section of the existing road surface at the junction of Werner Terrace and Brackley Lane. New kerbs will be installed, and the road surface will be reinstated to tie in with the new highway over the Calvert Road overbridge.

## What to expect

Expect periods of increased noise during the road construction. The works are expected to create low levels of vibration and we continuously be monitoring vibration levels. Calvert link road will temporarily close during these works. Vehicles will not be permitted along the road with the exception of the school and public bus service which will still operate to timetable. The link road will remain open for pedestrians and cyclists.

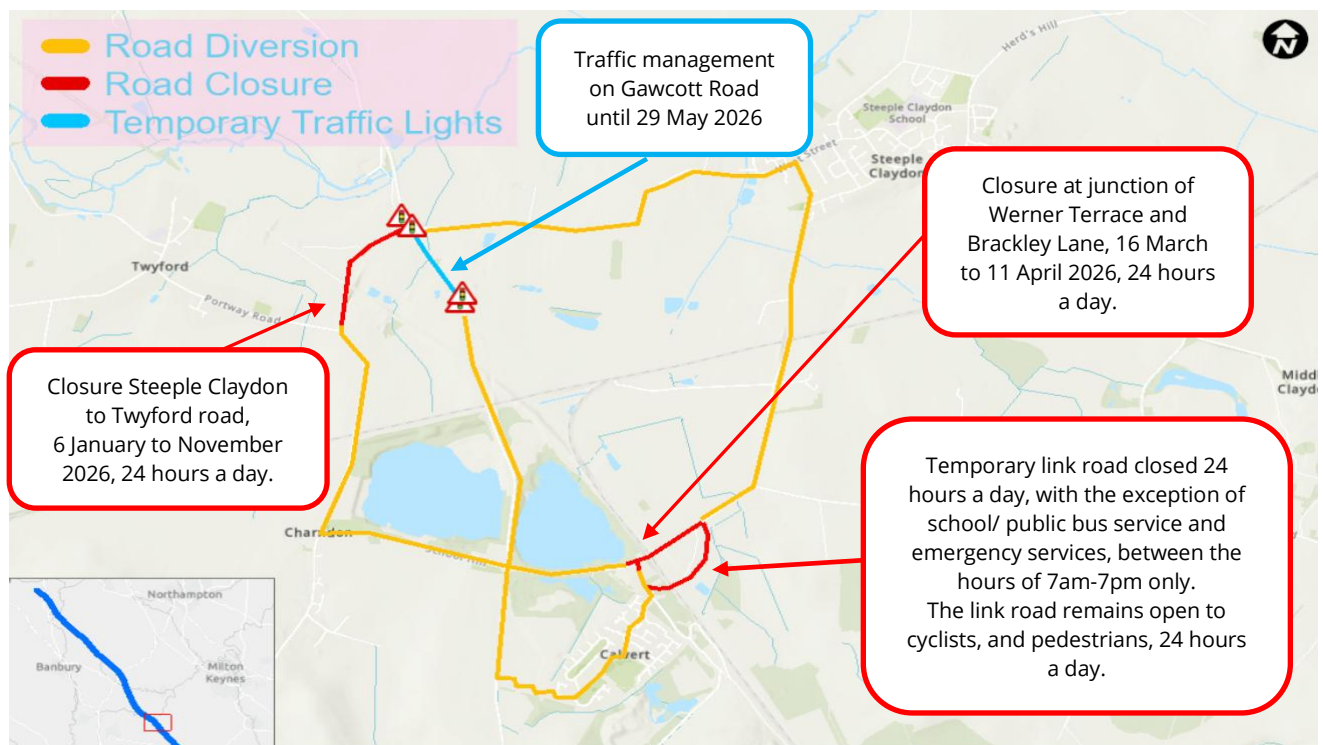

## Where we will be working

The map shows the location of the road closure on the junction of Werner Terrace and Brackley Lane, Calvert Green, from 16 March to 11 April 2026. It also shows the closure of the temporary road linking Calvert Green and the Claydon's and the Steeple Claydon to Twyford Road closure. Traffic management will be in place on Gawcott Road until 29<sup>th</sup> May 2026. Diversion routes are shown in yellow.

During morning and evening peaks, some delays are expected, but the system is working as designed and will remain in place for the duration of the closure. We ask that all road users follow the traffic signals at all times, avoid jumping any lights which will trigger any additional waiting times. We recognise the impact these works have on your daily journeys and routines, and we appreciate that this is frustrating. Your patience, respect for staff, and adherence to the restrictions is greatly appreciated.
