

Notice of spring chamber works, Wendover

Farmland area, northwest of Wendover, Buckinghamshire

Duration

Monday 13 April – Monday 6 July 2026

What we are doing

We will be constructing a spring flow chamber in the farmland northwest of Wendover. Deliveries to construct the spring chamber will be made from our Wendover green tunnel site. Access to the farmland will be via Nash Lee End.

What to expect

HGV deliveries from our Wendover green tunnel site. Some noise and disruption are expected during the construction phase particularly due to vehicle movement and localised vegetation removal. However, this will be managed carefully, and mitigation measures will be considered where appropriate.

What is a spring flow chamber?

A spring flow chamber is an underground chamber approximately 4m x 3m. This picks up the water from naturally occurring springs and releases it in a controlled manner into the watercourses to balance flows and is similar in size to a large manhole. The chamber will be accompanied by a smaller flow monitoring chamber which will be approximately 1m x 1m.

How will the works affect us as a community?

There has been a revised access route which means construction traffic will no longer use Dobbins Lane and South Street. However, future maintenance of the chamber may require occasional access via Dobbins Lane, likely limited to light vehicles and infrequent visits—potentially once a year.

Is the spring flow chamber essential for HS2?

Yes. The chamber is a requirement under Environment Agency consent and is necessary to manage groundwater levels and protect downstream water bodies such as the Wendover and Stoke brooks. The map below shows the route of our deliveries from the Wendover green tunnel compound.
