

# Temporary overnight full closures on the M6 J4 and J4A, including the M42 J7A link to the M6 northbound

## Location

Between M6 J4 and J4a, including the M42 J7A link to the M6 northbound.

## Duration

**M6 northbound full carriageway closure from Junction 4, with lanes 2 and 3 closed on the M6 southbound.**

Each night from Friday 8 May to Monday 11 May 2026, between 9pm and 5am.

**M6 southbound full carriageway closure from Junction 4a, including the M42 Junction 7A link road, with M6 northbound lanes 2 and 3 closures.**

Each night from Monday 11 to Saturday 16 May 2026, between 9pm and 5am.

**M6 southbound Junction 4 exit slip road closure**

Each night from Monday 18 to Saturday 23 May 2026, between 9pm and 5am.

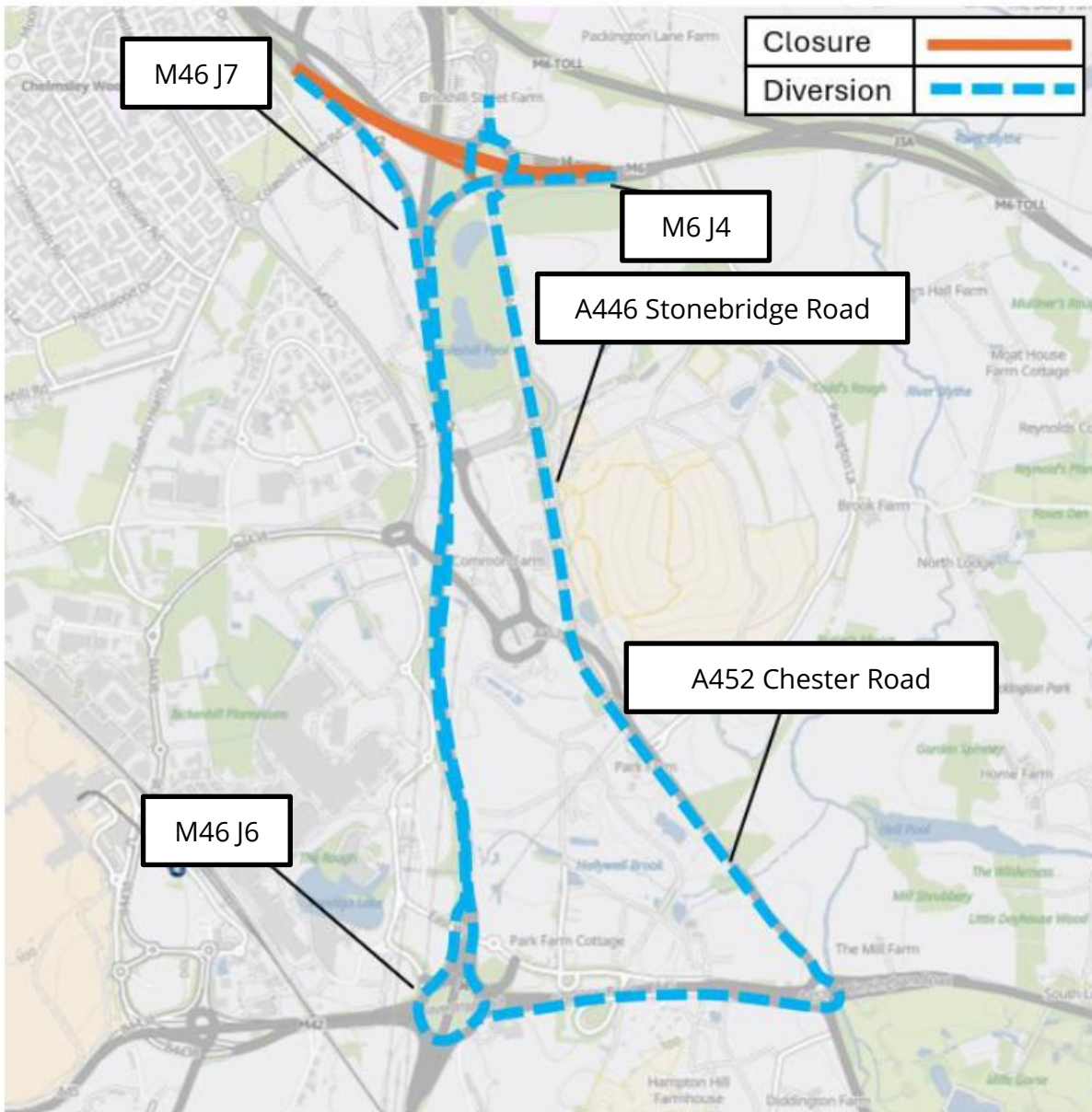

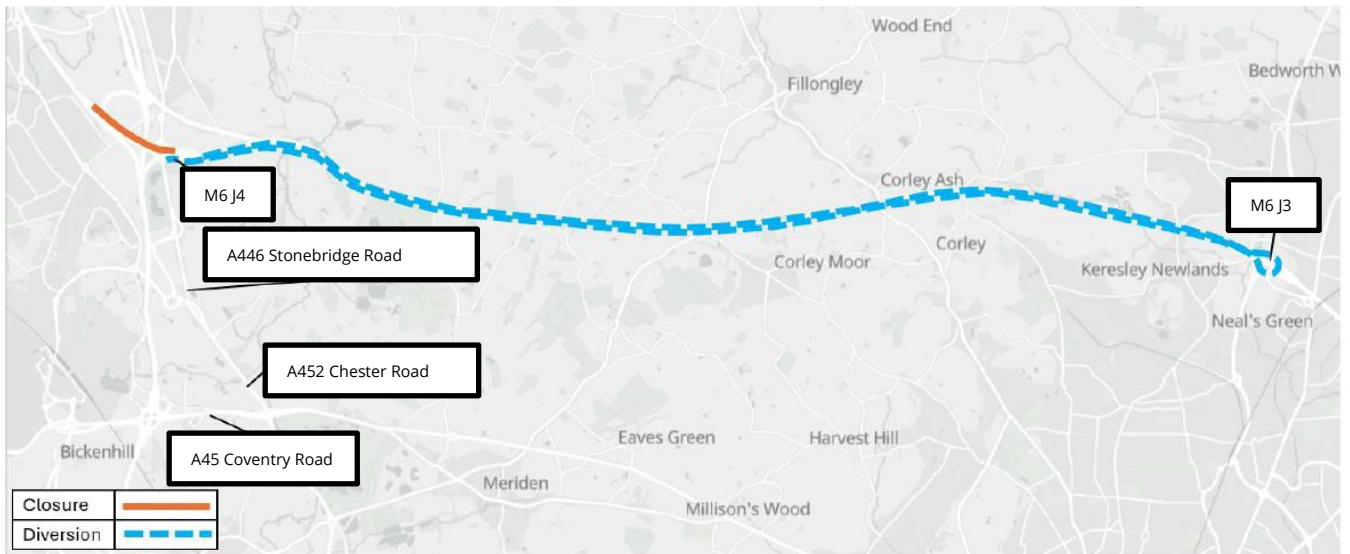
### M6 northbound diversion route

The M6 South viaduct will carry the new high-speed railway over the M6 motorway and adjoining slip road, near Birmingham Business Park, Birmingham Airport and the NEC in Solihull. This section of the M6 Motorway is located near Chelmsley Wood, between junction 4 northbound and 4a southbound, as well as the M42 junction 7a northbound.
