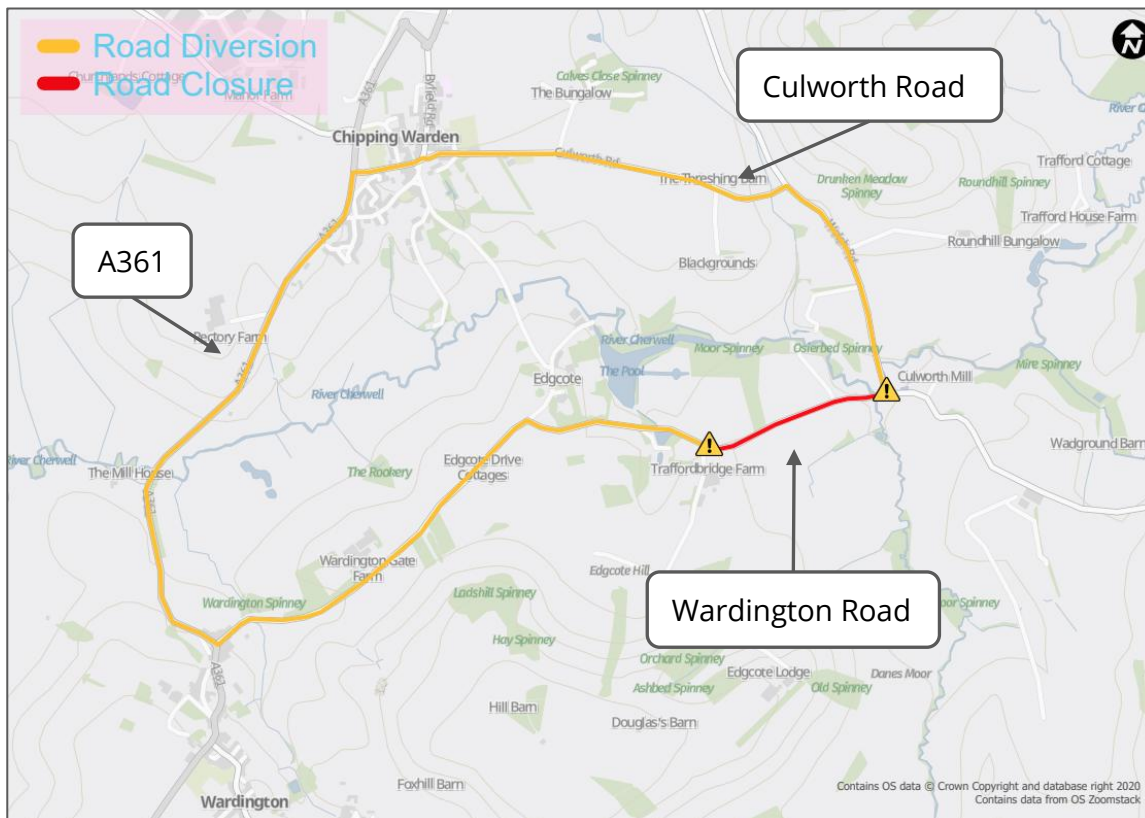
Additional information
