Road closure for temporary diversion of Thames Water main on Old Oak Common Lane

Update (Thursday 2 April): 10:00pm on Friday 10 April until Monday 13 April at 05:00am

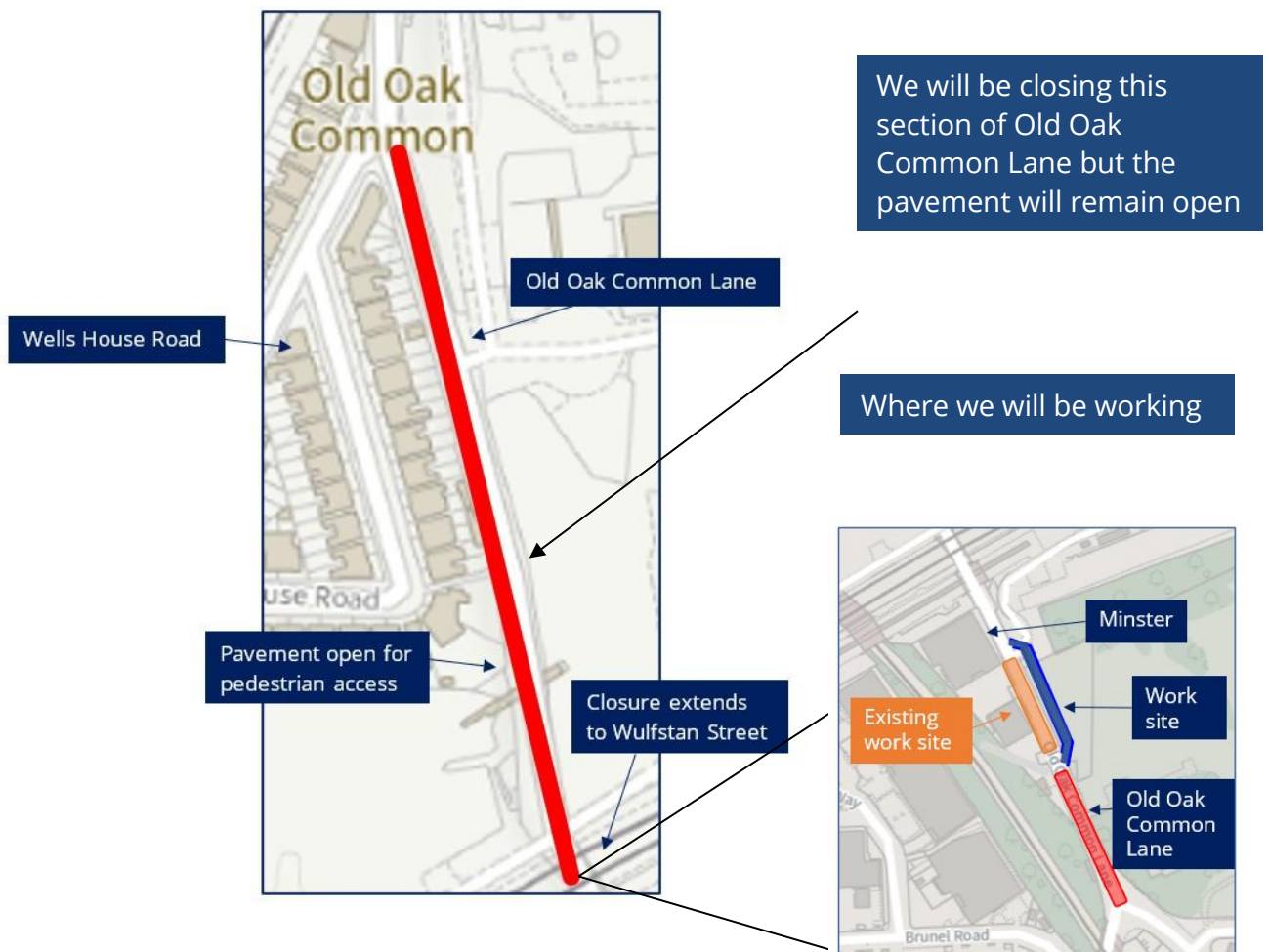
Due to construction challenges, we were not able to complete the works during the road closure on Friday 27 March until Monday 30 March. We therefore need to change the pre-planned road closure on Old Oak Common Lane from the north to the south of the road from Friday 10 April at 10pm until Monday 13 April at 5am.

We are moving a Thames Water main running under Old Oak Common Lane near Minster and Walking on Wood to allow HS2 tunnels to be built under the road later this year.

We will also be carrying out a repair to the water main in the area (highlighted below, right) We will need to excavate the road, and we will reinstate the surface when this work is finished. There will be no impact on residential water services. We do not expect the noise impact on residents to be severe, given the distance from properties. However, we will be working 24/7, throughout the day and night, over the weekend and some noise may be heard.

The section of Old Oak Common Lane highlighted in red below will be closed during these works although the pavement will be usable. All traffic will be diverted around to enter and leave Wells House Road from the north (towards the Atlas Road roundabout). The tunnels which will need to go underneath Old Oak Common will be constructed by our partner, SCS, and you can read more about that work here: https://assets.hs2.org.uk/wp-content/uploads/2024/10/UPDATE_HS2-SCS-25-1141-Old-Oak-Common-Tunnel-October-2025.pdf
