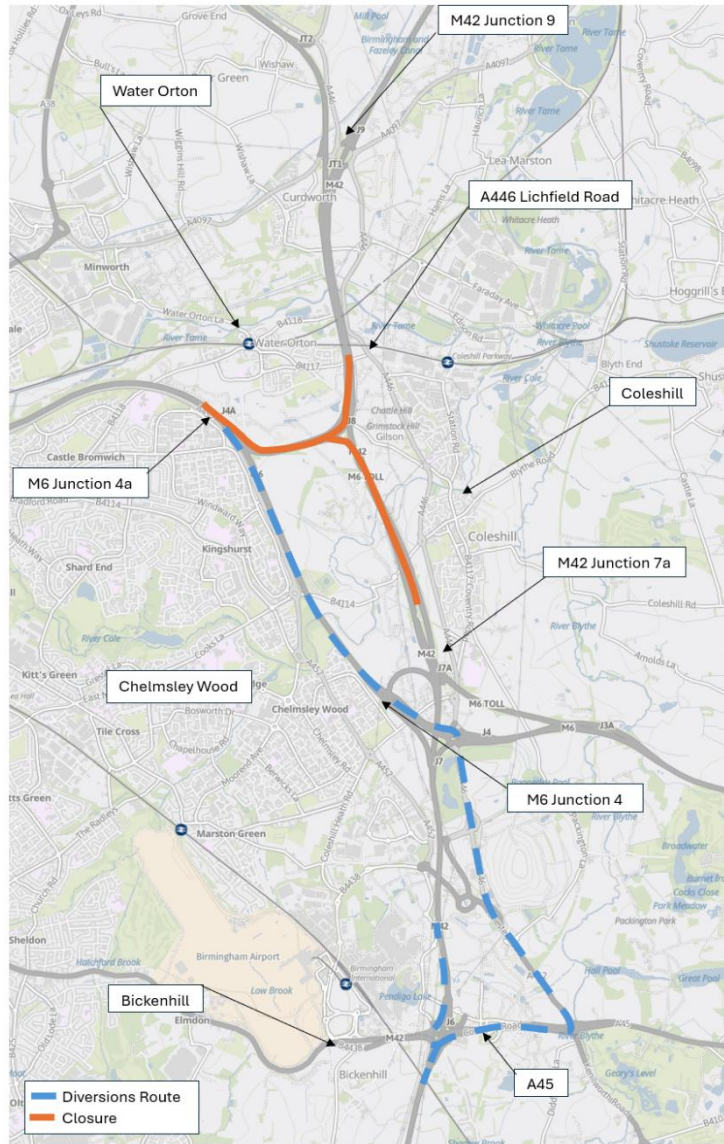

Location of works and diversion route:

Drivers on the M6 southbound should continue to junction 4 and exit onto the slip road, taking the third exit at the roundabout onto the A446 (Stonebridge Road). Continue south to the A45 roundabout at Stonebridge and take the third exit onto the A45 westbound, following it to M42 junction 6. From there, drivers heading for the M42 southbound should take the second exit, while those joining the M42 northbound should take the fifth exit, where the diversion ends.
