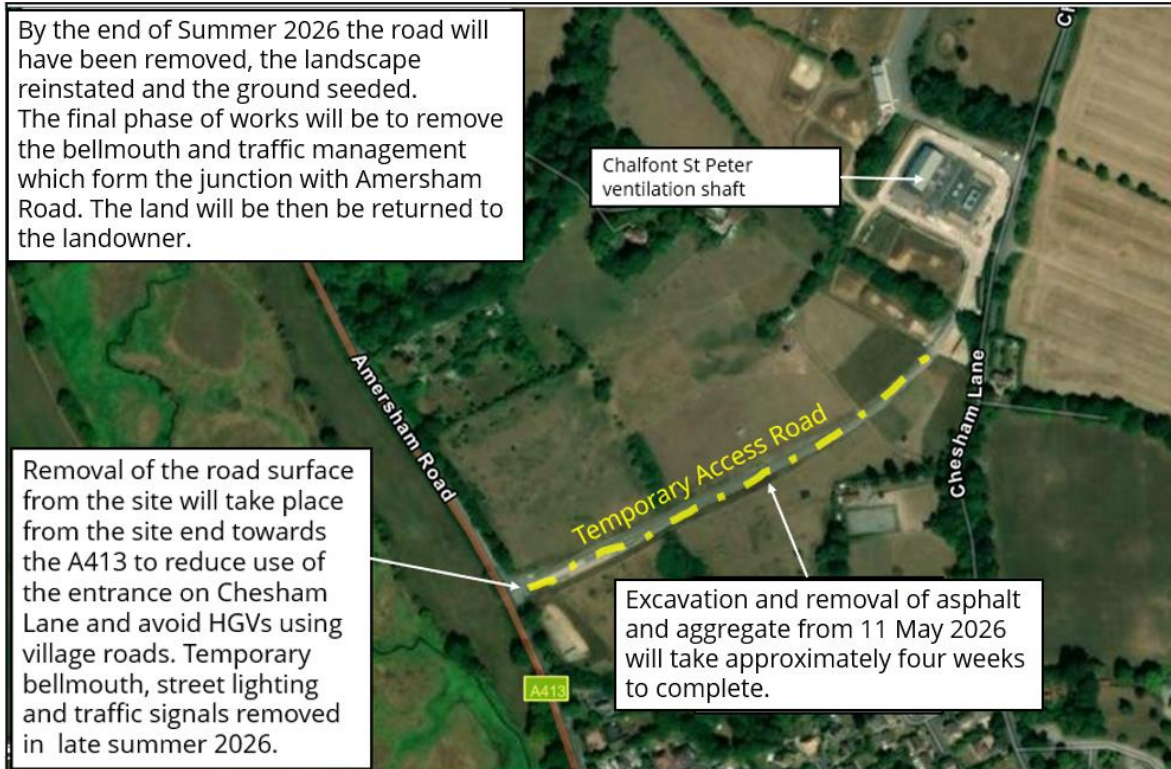

Where we will be working



Works will take place in the following phases:

Dates	Activity
11 May to early June	Removal of asphalt by excavators and Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGVs)
Early June to July	Reinstatement of land using stockpiles already on site (HGVs and excavators)
Late June to early July (exact dates to be confirmed)	Temporary lane closure on A413 to facilitate overnight works to remove junction at A413 and landscaping works. Removal of traffic signals and street lighting at roadside. These works are subject to further change. Full notice will be circulated in advance of any road closure or traffic management.
