What we are doing

We will be installing monitoring equipment into the ground under the footway on Albert Road. This equipment will allow us to accurately measure and monitor any ground movement before, during and after the tunneling works in the area.

What to expect

- A footway closure and pedestrian diversion on Albert Road
- Parking bay suspensions on Albert Road
- Noise from machinery when digging the pavement
- Noise barriers will be in place where possible

We will be digging a hole in Albert Road next to the junction with Canterbury Terrace near the Network Rail access gate. We will then install monitoring equipment below ground level.

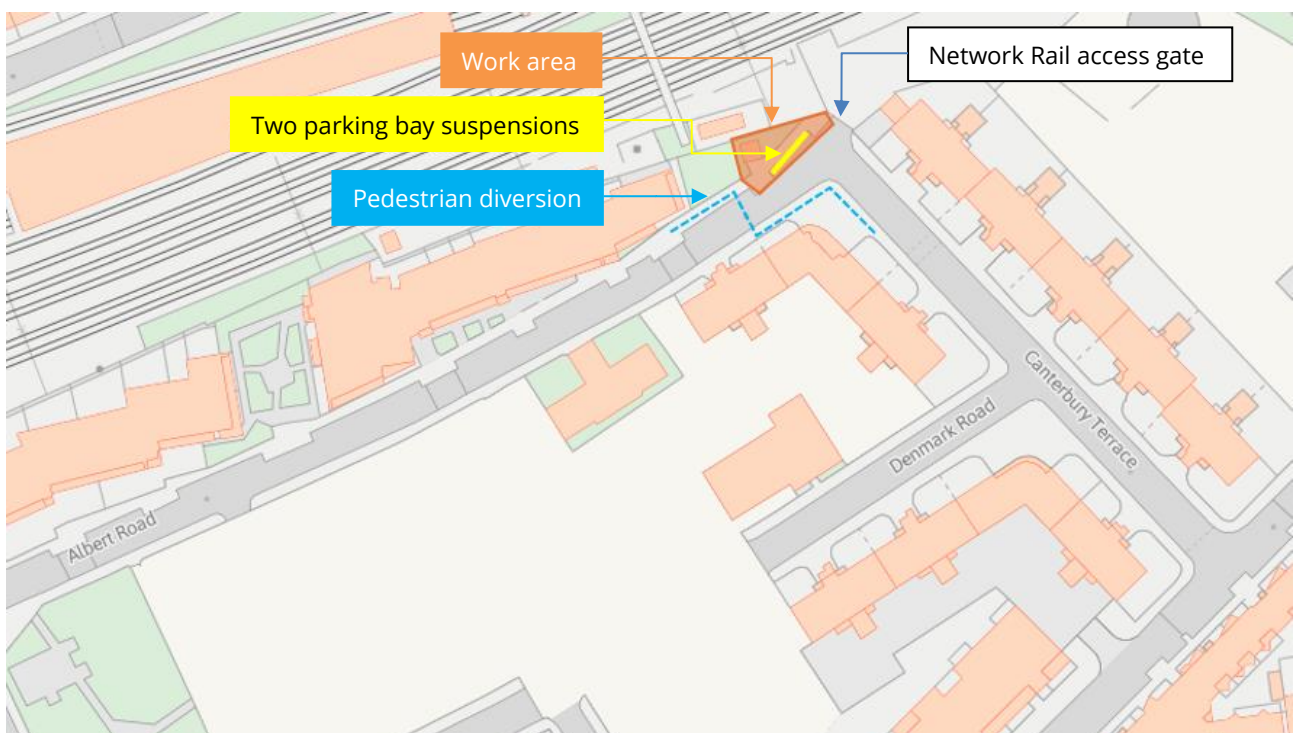
During the work we will suspend two parking bays near the access gate and create an exclusion zone around the work area. This is to ensure the safety of both pedestrians and the site team.

You can expect some noise as we use equipment to break the ground surface prior to installation. Once installation is complete, we will reinstate the footway and parking bays.
