

# Start of works to remove Temporary Access Road at Chalfont St Peter ventilation shaft

## Location

Chalfont St Peter ventilation shaft site, Chesham Lane, Chalfont St Peter, Buckinghamshire

## Duration

March 2026 to October 2026.

## What we are doing

The construction of the ventilation shaft at Chalfont St Peter, Buckinghamshire has now been completed. We will now remove the Temporary Access Road (TAR) which we used to reroute our HGVs and deliveries away from village roads via the A413 Amersham Road. Temporary office units will be installed in March, and removal of the road surface and replacement of earthworks and landscaping will follow in April lasting until late autumn 2026.

## What to expect

Increased movement of earthmoving vehicles in and around the compound and the fields adjacent to the site. HGVs, excavators, and operatives will be working on the TAR and using the junction with the A413 in the day.

## The construction and removal of the TAR at Chalfont St Peter

The TAR at Chalfont St Peter, Buckinghamshire was created to re-route HGVs and deliveries away from quiet village roads in Chalfont St Peter during the peak period of construction.

The soil excavated from the cutting has been stored in stockpiles behind the ventilation shaft site and will now be used to reinstate the fields, which will be returned to the landowner.
