We may be on site an hour before and after to set up and clear down.

What we are doing

Overnight CCTV survey within the sewer. This is to check the condition of the sewer prior to tunnelling in the area.

What to expect

Traffic management will be set up at Berens Road junction with Pember Road, and Rainham Road junction with Wakeman Road. To facilitate these works, five parking bays will need to be suspended on both Berens Road and Rainham Road. Suspended bays will

include two disabled bays.

We will gain access to the sewer through the required manholes at Rainham Road junction with Wakeman Road, and Berens Road junction with Pember Road.

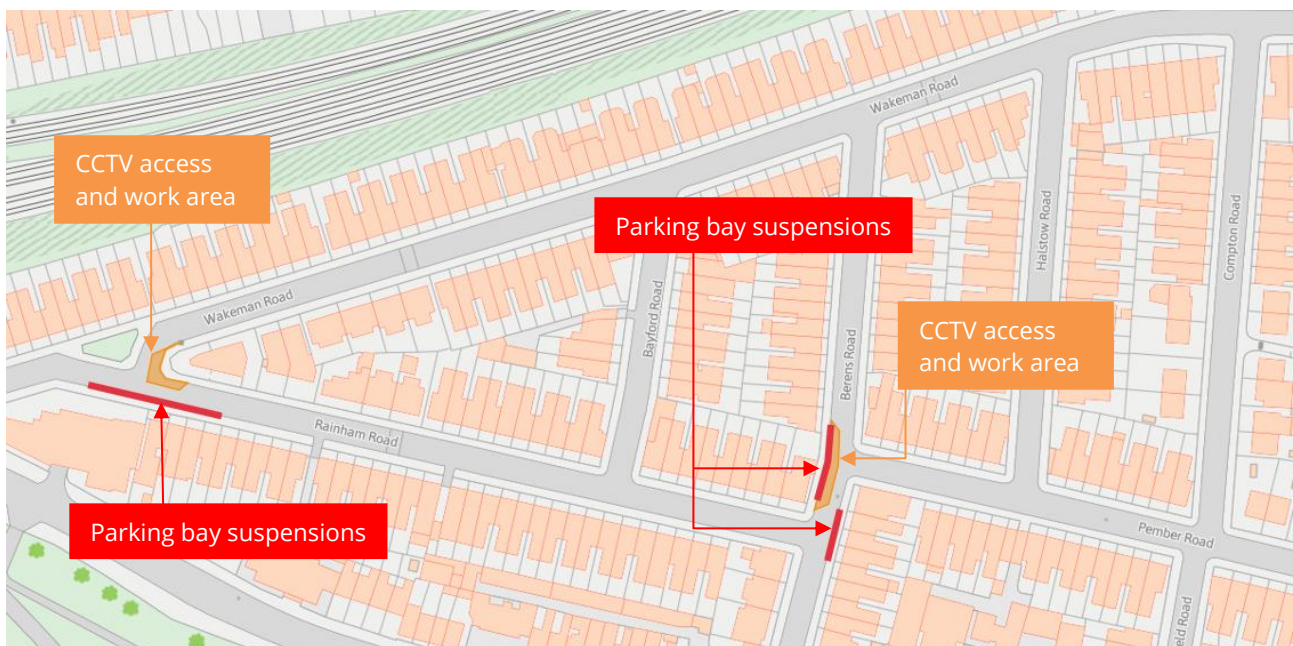
The access will require no water jetting or suction but will require a down-hole CCTV camera and survey vehicle which includes the use of a small generator inside.

Traffic cones and barriers will be in place to ensure a safe working area. During works there will be a narrowing of the carriageway next to the work area.

You may notice some noise as operatives carry out the works. Noise screening will be erected where necessary and reasonably practicable. The approximate location of the work is shown on the map below.
