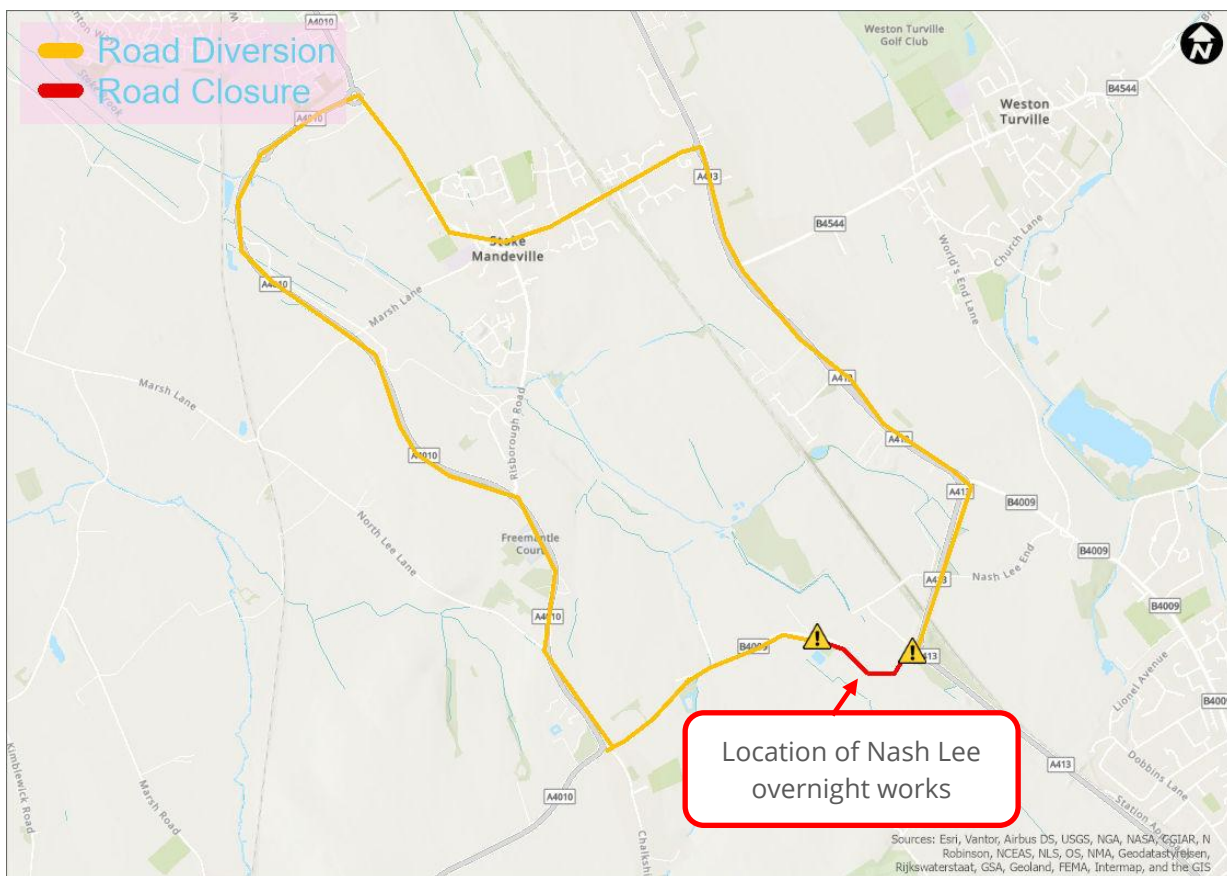
Additional information

To carry out the maintenance, we will be closing the road overnight for two nights. This ensures the safety of road users whilst the bridge is being inspected, and the safety of our operatives, who will be working in and around the carriageway.

We are working overnight to reduce the impact of this closure on road users. Future maintenance will be conducted periodically while the bridge is in operation.
