Old Oak Common Station, on the northern edge of the site.

Duration

May 2026 – April 2027

What we are doing

Works that began last year to build a new substation to house the electrical systems for the future Old Oak Common Station are continuing this year. After last year's sheet piling, our teams will be pouring the concrete base slab for the substation. Various reinforced concrete works will continue until April 2027.

What to expect

Mitigations will be in place from any potential noise and dust from concrete works. The presence of a large crane from mid-May 2026.

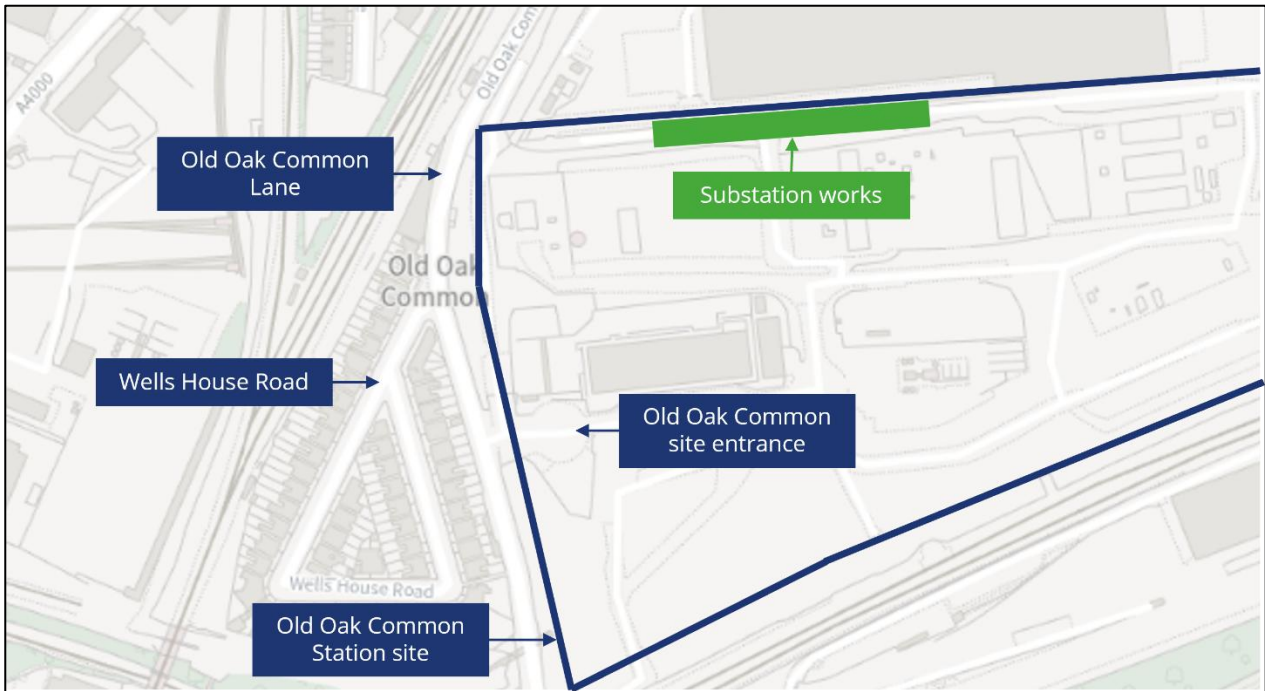
