### What we are doing

UKPN will be carrying out a series of excavations in the area to divert electrical cables below the road surface. These works are required to ensure the network is secure.

### What to expect

- Lane closures
- Footway closures
- Bus stop suspensions on Victoria Road
- Cycle lane suspensions
- Temporary traffic lights
- Noise from excavation works. UKPN will use noise reducing barriers where possible
- Allow more time for your journey, particularly if driving or using buses
- Your utilities will not be affected

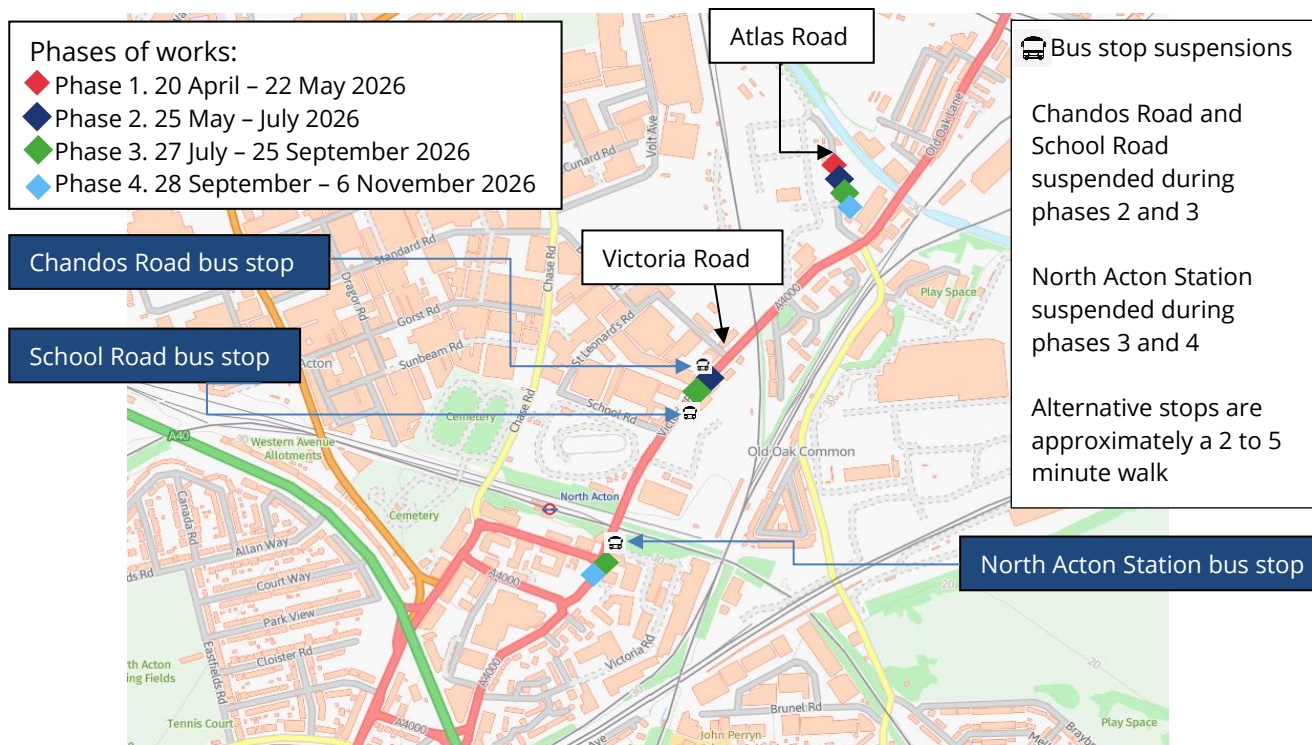
