Gas main connection to be completed over the new bridge.

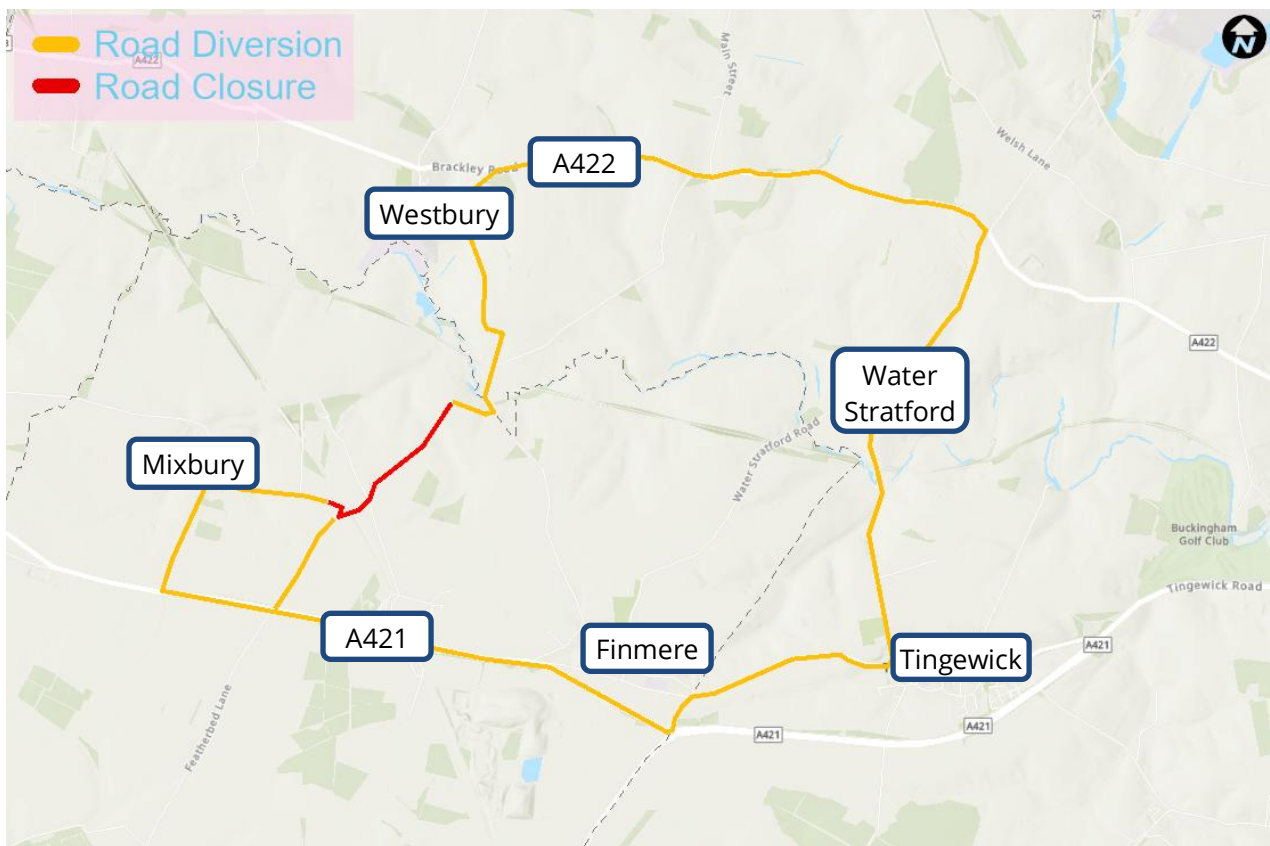

Due to the narrow road and the location of the road connections, it is not feasible to complete these works using traffic lights. A full road closure is the most efficient and safest method to complete the work as quickly as possible.
