## Location

A425 Leamington Road, near Southam

## Duration

Daytime closure in place from Tuesday 5 May until Sunday 31 May 2026 on the A425 Leamington Road, near Dallas Burston Polo Club: 9.30am – 3.30pm weekdays and 7am – 2pm during the weekends, with overnight temporary traffic lights.

**Update: Additional 24/7 road closure will now be needed from 7am Saturday 23 May to 6pm Monday 25 May.**

## What we are doing

We will be working on the permanent diversion of electrical assets, also constructing the new bellmouth for the future mechanical, electrical and pumping building.

You may notice increased levels of construction activity and some travel disruption. There will be a fully signed diversion in place. Please see the map on page two.

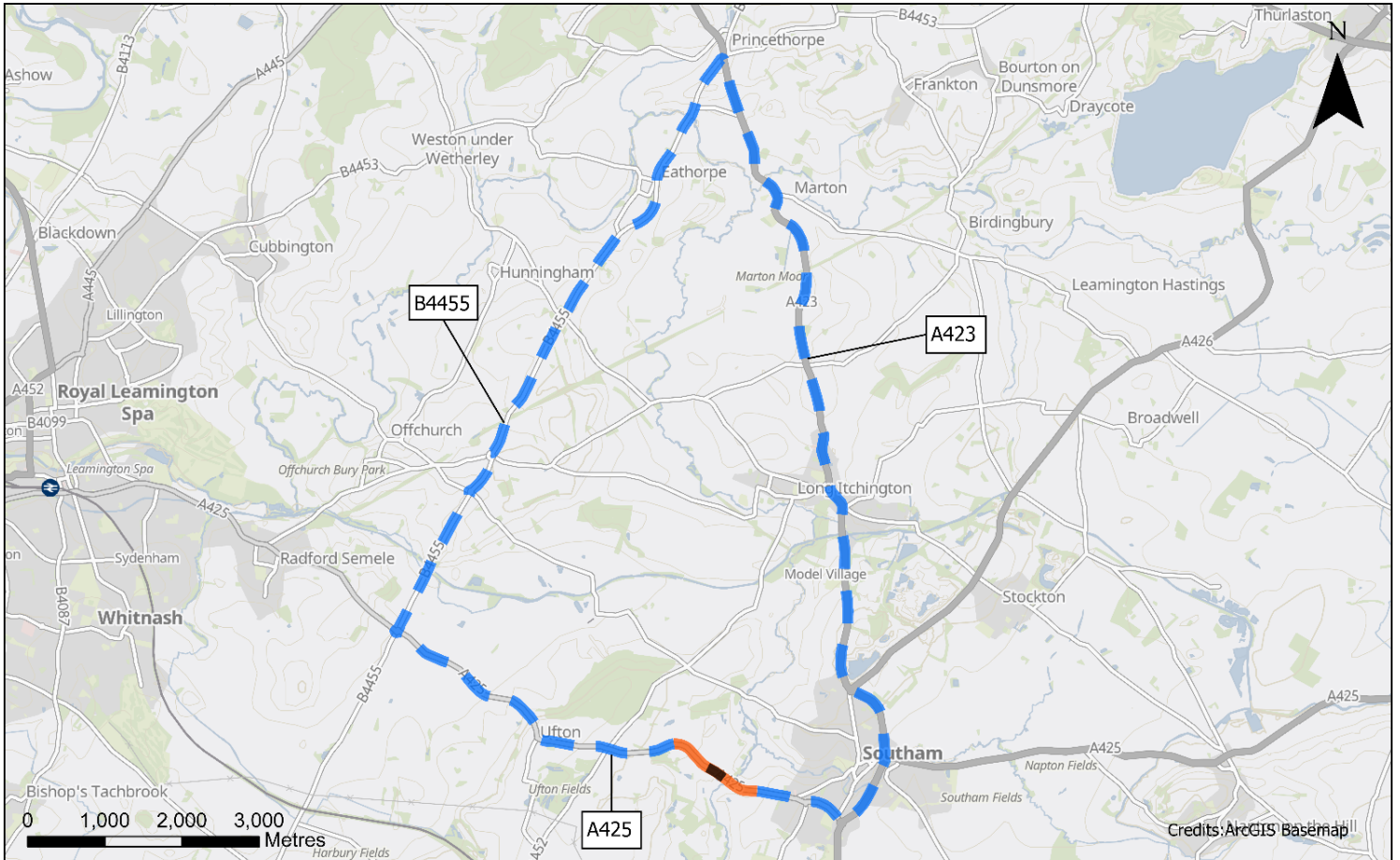

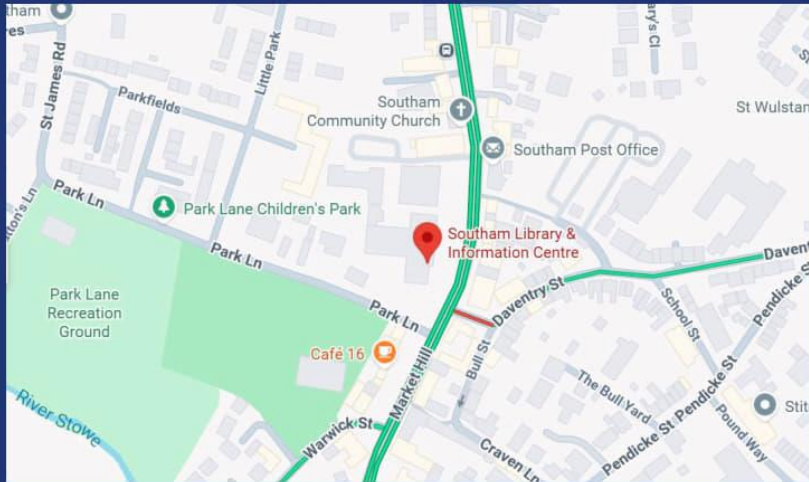
