

# Upgrading power cables – removing vegetation and installing hoarding

### Location

Old Oak Common site, south of Wells House Road

### Duration

Monday 15 June 2026 until 30th August 2026

### What we are doing

Clearing vegetation, removing old rusty chain link fences and installing new hoardings along the boundary. We will also level the ground to our site.

### What to expect

Noise from strimmers to remove vegetation, noise from an excavator to lower the ground to make the area nearer properties in-line with the current work area.

Works will be during regular working hours (Monday to Friday, 8am to 6pm, Saturday, 8am to 1pm). We won't start noisy works before 9am on Saturdays.

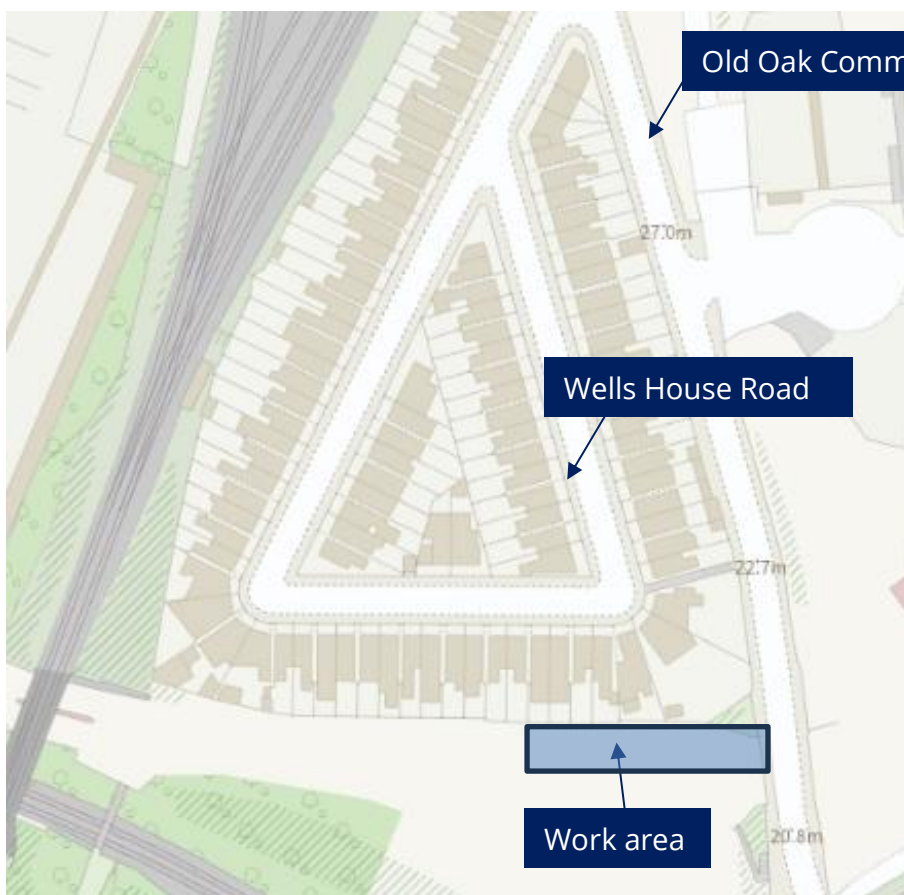

## What are we doing

We are upgrading power cables to modernise the network ahead of the opening of the station and guarantee its long-term stability. As part of the renewal, we need to install new ducts underneath the railway bridge and along the south of Wells House Road to protect the cables.

We are working with utility companies to update their cables and pipes, which will mean less disruption to residents and businesses in the future. We need to clear some vegetation around the back of residents' properties, south of Wells House Road. The work also includes ground reduction to make the area nearer properties level with the current work area. This is to provide a safe area for us to carry out the work. This will be done with an excavator. We will install an approx. 3.6m tall hoarding on the back of the properties for safety, which may reach above the fences of some gardens.
