

Overnight closure of Lawley Middleway - A4540

Part of Birmingham's Ring Road

Location

Lawley Middleway (A4540) Between Garison Circus and Curzon Circus

Duration

A southbound only closure from 10pm until 6am each night from 22nd May until 7 June, and a full closure 10pm until 6am each night from 25th May until 27th May

What we are doing

In August 2025, we successfully launched the Lawley Middleway Bridge, a key element of the new railway that will carry high-speed trains over Lawley Middleway and directly into the centre of Birmingham.

We now need to prepare the structure for the installation of the bridge deck. This work will include removing elements of the temporary substructure and installing the required drainage. We have carefully planned this work to take place during the school holidays and over a bank holiday weekend, when overnight traffic levels are generally much quieter.

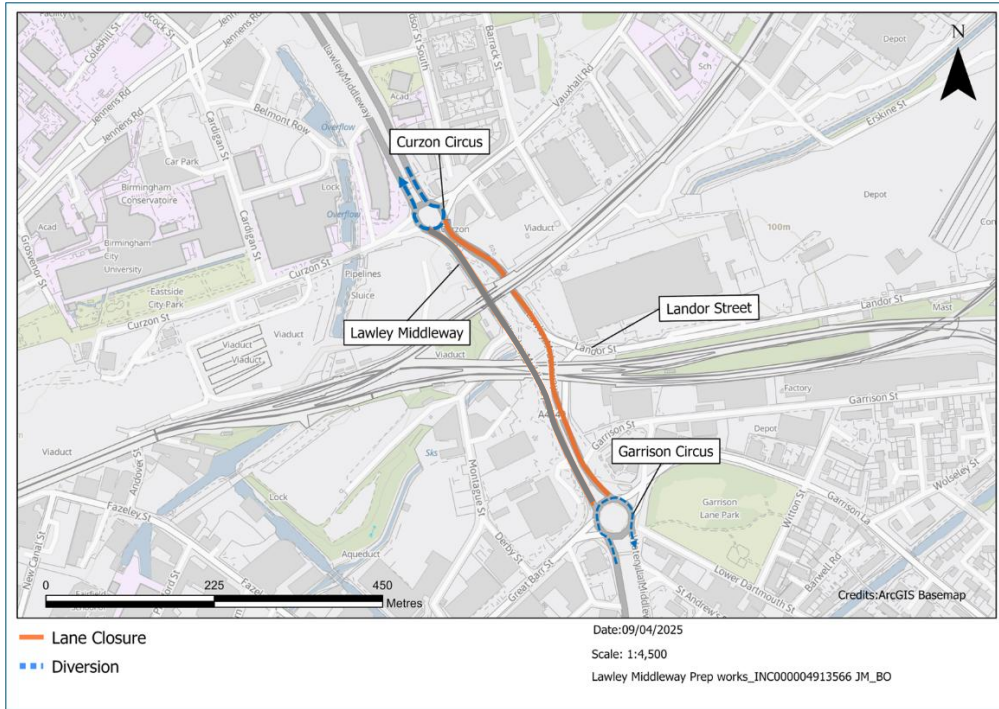

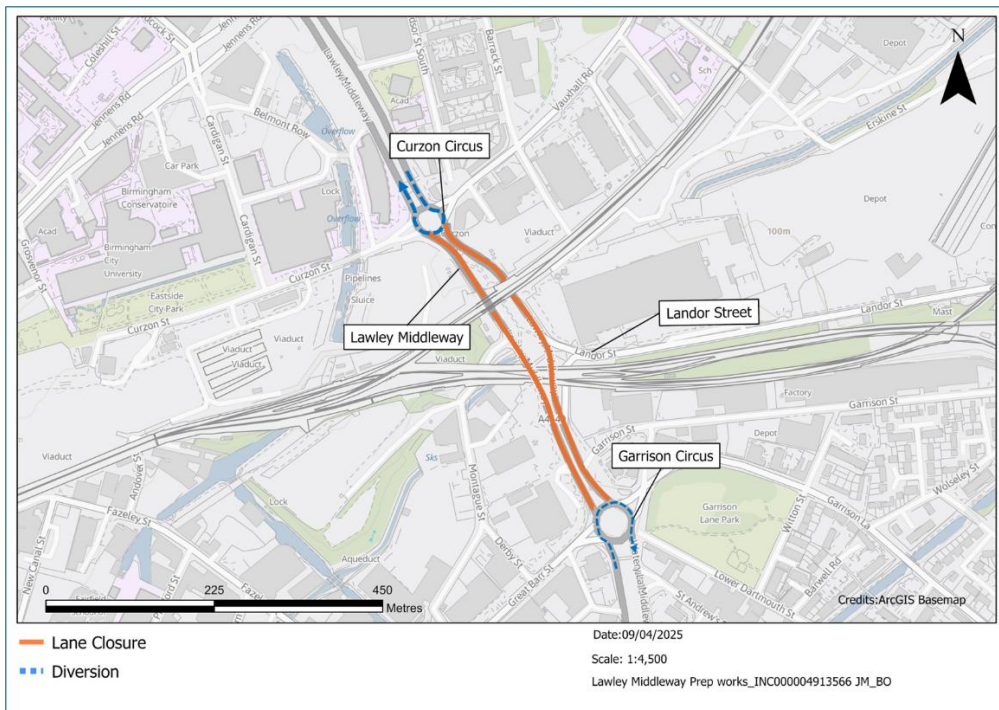
Closure area - Southbound

From 22nd May until 7th June, the southbound carriageway will be closed each night from from Garrison Circus to Curzon Circus



Closure area - Northbound

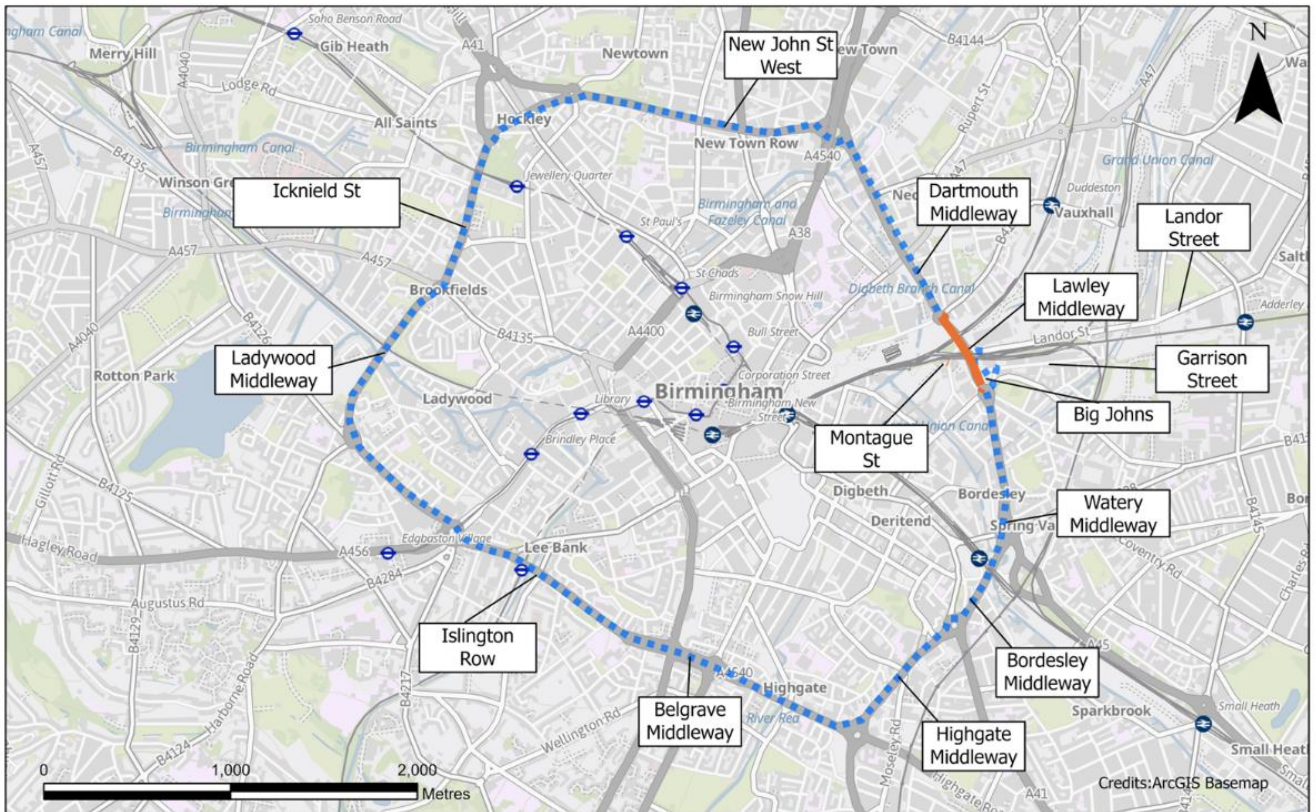
From 25 May until 27 May, the northbound carriageway will be closed each night from Garrison Circus to Curzon Circus resulting in a full closure of this section of the ring road



Diversion Route

Vehicles will be diverted via the ring road. However, road users are free to choose alternative routes if they prefer. Please note that the official diversion route has been planned to avoid entering the Birmingham Clean Air Zone (CAZ). For more information about the CAZ, please visit:

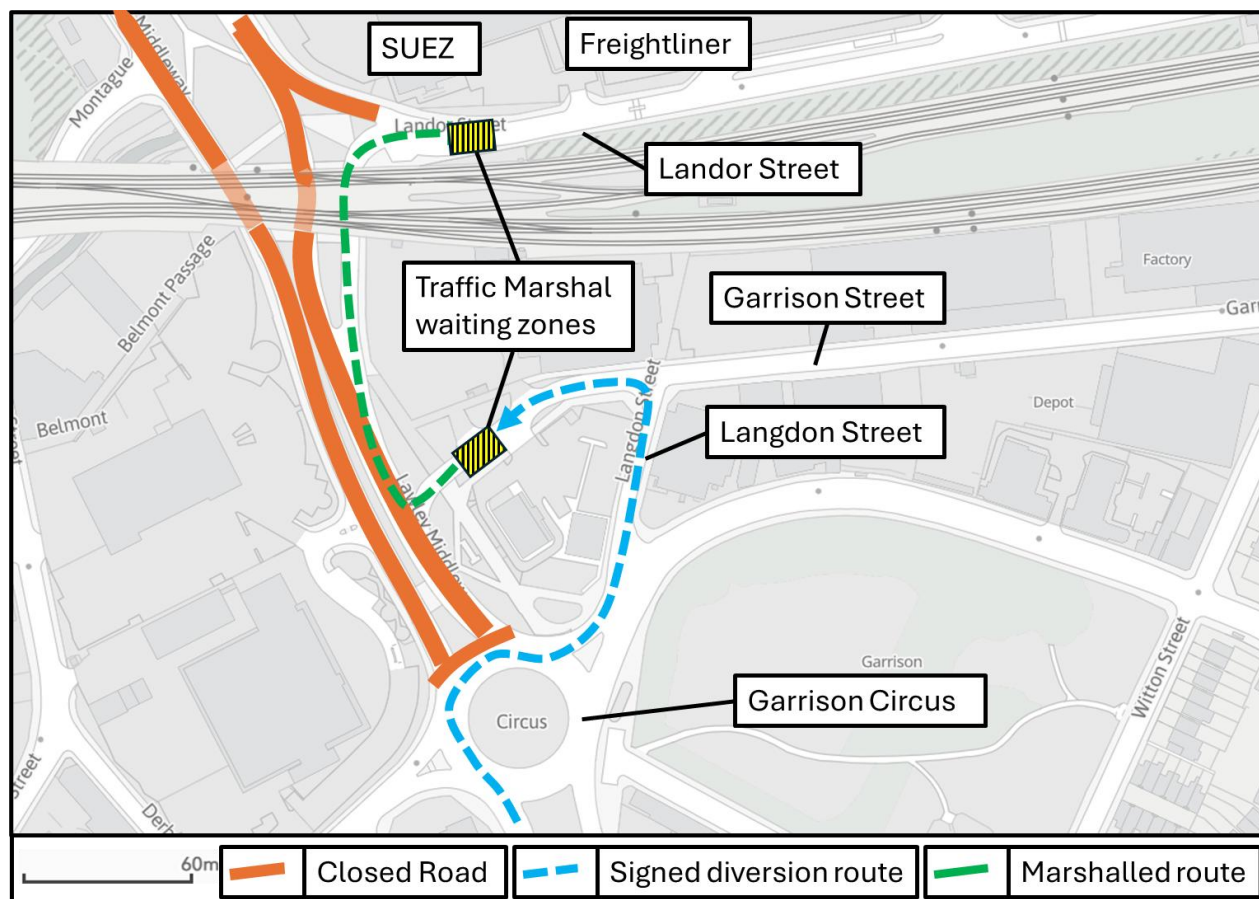

Access arrangements for Landor Street

Between 10pm and 6am, vehicles will be diverted (fully signed) onto Langdon Street, where they'll be met by one of our traffic marshals. The marshal will then escort vehicles northbound using the southbound carriageway onto Landor Street.

We'll also have marshals assisting any vehicles leaving Landor Street, to ensure everyone remains safe throughout the closure
