## Location

A38 Northbound slip road at Streethay

## Duration

Closure of the A38 northbound slip road at Streethay from **Friday 27 March 2026** to **Saturday 31 October 2026**

These works are subject to consent.

## What we are doing

We are completing work to build the Rykneld St bridge that will allow the HS2 railway to pass under the existing A38 carriageway.

The northbound slip road closure is required to complete all remaining work and the permanent realignment of the A38.

Some low-level noise may be generated in the area during working hours.

## Where we will be working

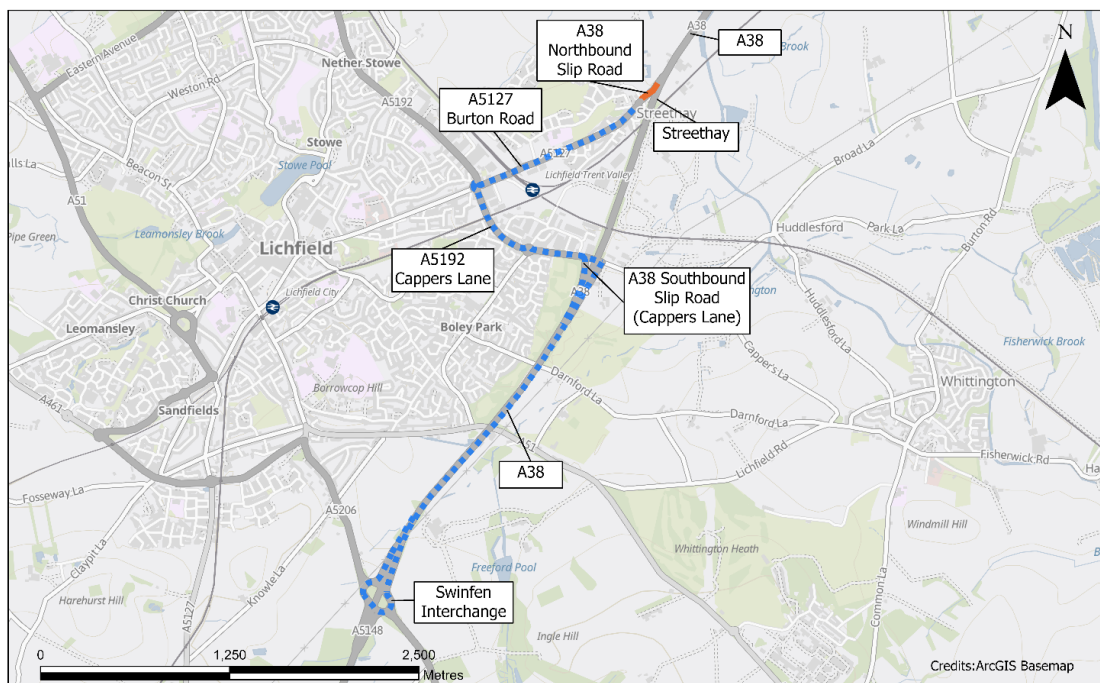
We will be working on the A38 northbound slip road in Streethay

## A38 northbound slip road closure diversion route

- From Trent Valley roundabout exit onto the A5192 Cappers Lane
- Continue straight over the roundabout and turn right to join the A38 southbound
- Keep left on the A38 and exit towards Swinfen Interchange
- Take the 4<sup>th</sup> exit to rejoin the A38 northbound
