The abnormal load vehicles will arrive at Curzon Street site for 6.30am, the U-beams will then be lifted off the vehicle by a 300-tonne crane and temporarily stored ahead of permanent installation.

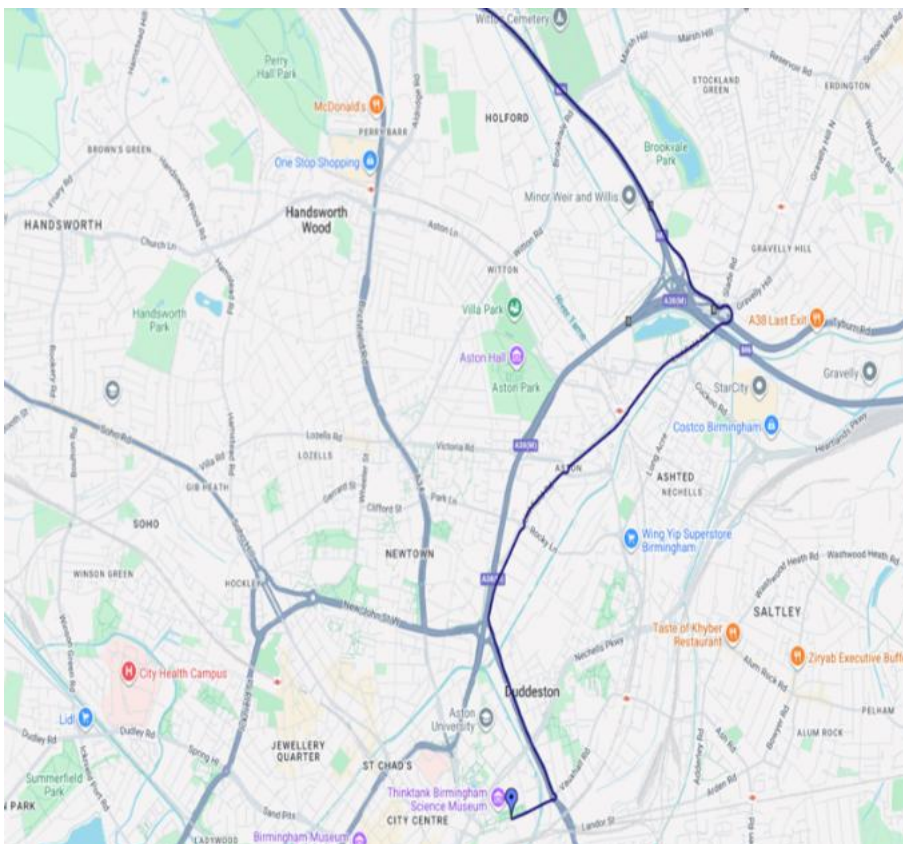
Additional information

Delivery vehicles will assemble at Junction 11 of the M6, where they will undergo police inspection at 5:30am, before proceeding to Curzon Street under police and abnormal load escort.
