

Updated 03/09/2026 Overnight Central Line bridge work

HS2-OOC - SCP-26-2078

Location

Old Oak Common station site (west of Old Oak Common Lane, south of Wells House Road).

Duration

Intermittently from June 2026 until October 2026. We will work overnight, within the hours of 10pm to 6am when the Central Line does not run.

What we are doing

We are continuing with work to support the construction of railway bridges on land near the Central Line. Residents can expect to experience some construction noise, within the limits allowed by agreement with the local authority.

What to expect

We have to carry out these works overnight, when it is safe to do so while trains are not running. We will complete our activity as quickly as possible to reduce disruption. We will use equipment and methods which help to reduce noise. We will engage directly with residents impacted by these works. The works are described in more detail overleaf.

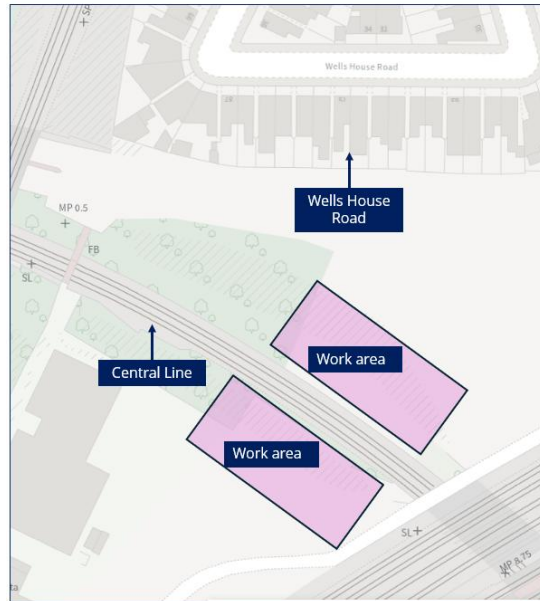

Where we will be working



Installing temporary works

We are continuing with our work to support the construction of railway bridges near the Central Line (around 90 metres south from the rear of properties on Wells House Road).

As part of the construction on the new bridge, we need to install a temporary wall to support the pouring of the concrete. The work will involve some drilling and fixing, and some machinery operating to lift in the temporary wall. We will be using a crane situated within site to lift sections of the temporary wall into position near the bridge.

As we are lifting towards and next to the railway, for safety reasons we need to carry out these works overnight whilst the Central Line is not operating. We have been continually updating this notification as works have progressed.

Working times

- Sunday 6 September – installing support beams (hand tools only)
- Sunday 13 September – Friday 18 September: Install temporary works, pour concrete
- Sunday 20 September – Friday 25 September: Install temporary works, pour concrete
- All working hours are Sunday to Thursday within 10pm – 6am
