What we are doing

We are beginning to remobilise the site to restart construction works following the safe stop of all construction activities on our site. Initial work will involve using a crane to facilitate steel beam installations within the ventilation shaft.

What to expect

You will notice increased activities and use of construction machinery on site, as well as additional operatives and deliveries. This may result in higher noise levels from construction works and the use of equipment and power tools.

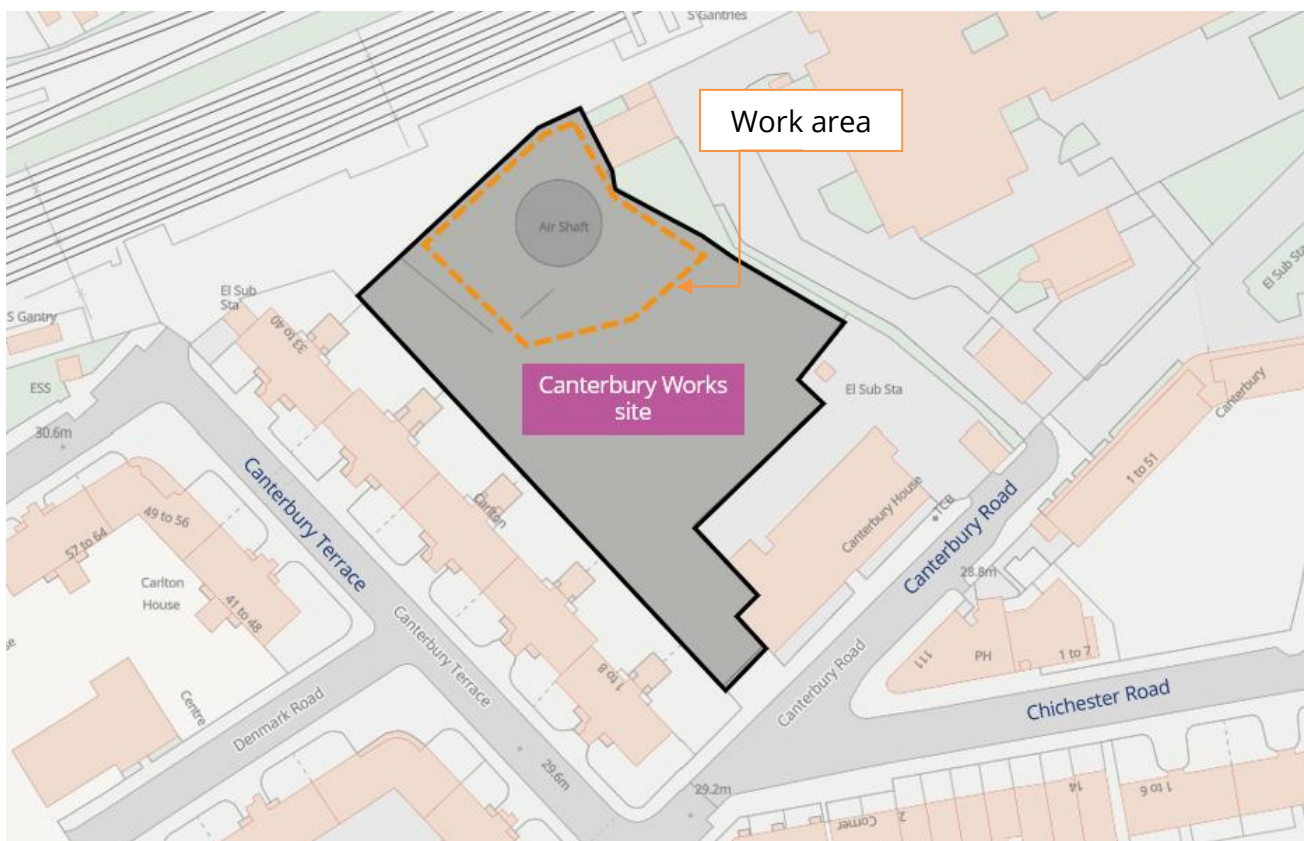
Additional information

We expect delivery of the crane and steel beams during the hours stated on the previous page. Once installed, the crane will lift the beams from ground level to the base of the shaft. The beams will then be fixed to the shaft wall using power tools, where they will act as temporary support ahead of the tunnel boring machine (TBM) passing below in the coming months.

We will monitor our activities to ensure we keep any disruption to a minimum.
